III. Strengthening PAAAA's role on the district and local level—Shared (Participatory) Governance—
Why involvement in this process is so critical for African Americans?

- a. District Academic Senate is comprised of 12 representatives, 3 from each college (College Senate President, Vice President, and an elected position).
- b. District Classified is comprised of representatives from each campus (College Senate President and at least one other college senate representative)

 - 1) **Hiring, Tenure, and Evaluation Committees**—How these committees are appointed.
 - 2) **District** - The Planning and Budgeting Integration Model (PBIM) is an integrated district-wide planning and resource allocation advisory model comprised of seven primary advisory committees:
Participatory Governance Council (PGC)
Planning and Budgeting Council (PBC)
District Academic Affairs and Student Services Committee (DAASSC)
District Facilities Committee (DFC)
District Technology Committee (DTC)

District Enrollment Management Committee (DEMC)
District Technology and Facilities Conference Committee (DTFCC)

- 3) **College Committees** (*committee name and functions will vary according to campuses—refer to you shared/participatory college manuals*): Academic & Classified Senates, Academic Support (Basic Skills), Accreditation, Budget Advisory, Classified Prioritization, College Council, Curriculum, Dis Ed, Enrollment Management, Facilities, Faculty Prioritization, Graduation, Health, Safety & Security, Institutional Effectiveness, Instructional Equip & Library Materials, Learning Assessment, Outreach & Retention Services, Professional Development, Search Committees, Student Services Council, Student Success & Equity, Technology Planning, Tenure Review, Faculty Evaluation, etc.
