

SUMMER WEEK OF CHOIR -JULY 27-AUGUST 2. 2020

WHAT: A corny week of looking for run-away chickens and learning to live by faith and not by sight! The students will learn and stage an entire musical in one week! There will be times of Bible Study, Bible Quizzing, Character Lessons, Friday Water Games, Fun & Fellowship!

WHO: All children who have completed Kindergarten through 6th Grade (Rising 7th graders) Invite your friends & children in your church or neighborhood!

DON'T WAIT! WE MUST HAVE AT LEAST 60 STUDENTS REGISTERED BY JULY 1 TO HAVE SWOC 2020!

WHEN: Monday through Friday, JULY 27th through 31st, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with **Required Performances AUGUST 1ST & 2ND at 6:00 p.m.**

Saturday, August 1, 2020, 6:00 p.m. Performance #1 (Spirit Awards!) Sunday, August 1, 2020, 6:00 p.m. Performance #2 (Character & Bible Quiz Awards!) (Students will need to arrive at 5:15 p.m. on Performance Nights.)

DETAILS:

Each child should bring a labeled sack lunch (no refrigeration provided) Monday through Thursday and a MASK for wearing between classes. (We will be making the groups smaller and spreading them out more.) We will provide lunch on Friday during our Fun Day. Drinks and snacks will be provided each day.

Camp registration fee is \$65.00 per child. (Fully refundable if we cancel SWOC!)

This provides your child with a Camp Shirt, a Camp Picture, a Book and CD of the musical, a fun-filled week of musical & spiritual activities, and a life-time of memories!

Costume Information: We will provide the Costume Shirt & Bandana to be worn at all performances. Your child will need his or her own nice blue jeans and clean tennis/athletic shoes.

Speaking Parts & Solos: Students who are awarded extra speaking parts, solos, lead roles, or other parts may need to find other costume items; of course, we will help with this by sewing or helping purchase any needed pieces. Lead roles will need to plan on extra rehearsals before SWOC week, and perhaps short rehearsals following each day.

AUDITION INFORMATION FORM

WHO:

Any child may try-out for any part or solo; however, you do NOT have to try-out to be part of SWOC! Please explain to your children that there are a limited number of solos and speaking parts. I prayerfully consider each child, trying to match them with the available parts.

WHEN: Auditions:

Tuesday, July 7th, 3:30-7:30 PM Friday, July 10th, 3:30-7:30 PM

Saturday, July 11th, 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM

Murdale Baptist Church, Foyer Entrance, Music Ministry Rooms (immediately to your right, up the stairs.) Fill out measurement papers when you arrive. Please call (618) 529-5800 and talk to our SWOC Secretary to make an appointment for your child. *Pre-Week Rehearsals for Soloists & Lead Roles:*

July 18, 10:00 AM-3:00 PM-Individuals & Groups will be scheduled. July 25, 12:00 Noon-4:00 PM-Individuals & Groups will be scheduled.



WHAT:

Every child must sing a solo with an accompaniment track.

(The SWOC musicals are performed with accompaniment tracks-<u>without</u> voicesand we <u>must</u> hear each child's ability to sing with a track. This is a different skill than singing along with a piano, guitar, recording artists, or a cappella!) You are welcome to bring your own accompaniment track or we can provide you with an accompaniment CD with a song from last year's musical. You may pick up the CD from the church office anytime after receiving this letter. Each accompaniment CD that is borrowed must be returned at the time of your child's audition because of copyright regulations.

DETAILS:

During the tryout we will work with your child for 10 to 15 minutes. Please remain in the foyer during this time. This gives us an opportunity to work with your child one-on-one, without distractions. (I will have a lady assisting me during the auditions.) All children must put preparation into their auditions; they must know their songs well! Please inform your children that, in the interest of time, they might not be able to sing the entire song. After the child sings a portion of the song, we will ask the child to read a few lines from a script and perhaps imitate some easy choreography. If there is a question about any of this, do not he sitate to call me *before the tryouts*.
