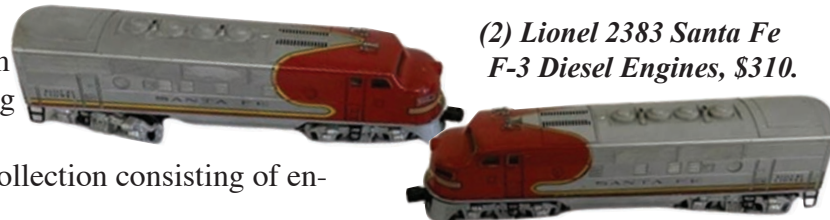

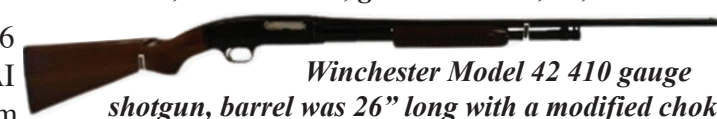
Shotguns included a Winchester 42 410 gauge, 12 20 gauge, 12 28 gauge and two 12 skeet 12 gauge, plus more.
