## Weathervanes Are Not Only Unique But Serve As An Instrument For Measuring Which Way The Wind Blows

Weathervane arrow, cast brass with tin Ram sheep, 23" long, 7" tall, good original, \$2,100.



Girard Auction and Land Brokers held a auction for the Ron and Darlene George collection of Topeka, Kansas. The auction consisted of a super collection of rare and unusual Farm Antiques with nearly 450 lots, all from a single collection.



Weathervane arrow, JAMES cast iron with large tin milk cow, LARGE SIZE, 23" long, 9" tall cow, looked like it was repainted at one time, no holes or major damage, nice one, \$1,800.

Windmill weight, BOSS 3-D 2-piece full-figured bull, 15" long, 13" tall, tip of the left ear was missing, did not look broken off, looked to have been casted that way, on a heavy wood block to display, we believed an old original, but not 100% sure, \$2,900.



Weathervane arrow, cast iron with copper rooster, 22" long, 9.5" tall, nice original, \$450.



We had over 25 original cast iron windmill weights that included several roosters and bulls and over 25 weathervane arrows that included animals.

With farm antiques from hog oilers, Winchester and Keen Cutter Tools, over 25 stoneware chicken waters, cast iron seats, egg scales, fencing tools and more.

There were unique advertising pieces from General Store, IH, Dairy and Livestock.

Windmill weight, large hollow body rooster, rare, 21" long, 20" tall, on a metal stand, end of the tail was broken off & had some large chips around the base, old paint was partially there, I believe this was the largest figural chicken weight known to have been produced, \$4,600.



Weathervane arrow, cast iron with etched blue glass tail, goose design, 18" long, metal was a little pitted, looked like it was cleaned at one time, \$575.

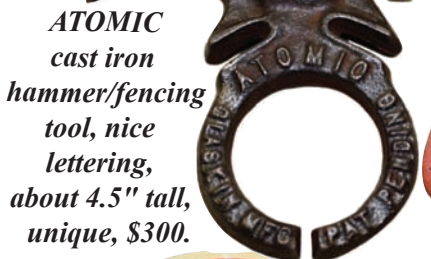
