

"And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you." — Matthew 17:20

Jesus was not talking about a measurement of faith, as though one could inspect their faith by using a ruler or a scale. He was talking about the object of their faith. Immediately after saying the disciples did not have enough faith, Jesus told them that if they even had faith as small as a tiny mustard seed, that would be enough to move a mountain!


It was not the amount of the disciples' faith but the object or focus of their faith. It is important to note that the Object and Focus of true faith is always Jesus!
In Matthew 17 the disciples tried unsuccessfully to cast out a demon. They had tried to cast it out depending on their own power. The object of their faith was their own strength. When they finally put Jesus as the object their faith, they had success. When our focus is on the right Person — in our all-powerful God — then even a tiny grain of faith is enough. Remember, nothing is impossible when our faith is in God.

This faith moves mountains and makes all things possible. Sometimes we may feel that we have great faith and at other times we may feel that our faith is small. Remember that it is the focus of our faith that works the impossible — that moves mountains!

Jesus gives us His promise: If you have faith in Me [Jesus], even if it seems as small as a mustard seed, then it is enough. Enough to move the mountains in your life. Enough for Me to do the impossible!

Lord Jesus, thank you for being the Son of God that makes the impossible possible. Help us to remember that when the focus of our faith is You, mountains will be moved!
