


I want to express my thanks for the good experiences shared by those who participated in the Missions Celebration 22 event. There were 11 HBA churches which took part in one way or another to make the week-end a success. A total of 14 missionaries (some local) shared stories, information, and testimonies about their call to missions and the things they have encountered trying to tell the good news to people around the world. We were enlightened about the number of people groups that have not heard about Jesus and His saving power. We heard about the difficulties and problems facing those ministering in countries where Christianity is not accepted. We heard about hopes for the future concerning what our churches and church members need to be doing to help promote the gospel. The three actions needed most are (1) Pray. Every church member can obtain information about what's happening on the mission fields and set aside a time to pray. (2) Give. It's pretty easy to give a few dollars to missions, but maybe some (or all) of us could give a little more to support the work. (3) Go. Some of us can go personally to do missions. It doesn't have to be in Japan or China or Mexico. There are short-term workers needed for local or Missouri missions. And just outside your door or even in your own family are those who need to hear. Mission trips supported by HBA would help you go for a week or so. In addition, my personal thanks to the "crew" that put it all together. Corey Anstine, David & Jeanie Bergman at East Sedalia Church, John and Peggy Barrett help lots with planning and executing the work. Seth Nevels put some muscle into the Celebration by helping set up the tables and chairs and clean-up. And it wouldn't have happened without Ruth, who did much at the office and planning menus and making food available. I hope we take away a better understanding of how important it is to be responsible Christians in telling the Good News.

### What Does It Mean That “Your Faith Can Move Mountains”?

Faith is not a mustering of will or a power to wield. Faith comes from trusting in God and His will. What Jesus is advocating is something far more radical in Matthew 17:10. “Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.”

What do we have faith in? Faith in our own abilities? In a favorable outcome? We need to have faith in our God!! Jeremiah 10:12-13 says, “God made the earth by His power, and he preserves it by his wisdom. With his own understanding he stretched out the heavens. When he speaks in the thunder, the heavens roar with rain, he causes the clouds to rise over the earth. He sends the lightning with the rain and releases the wind from his store houses.” The Lord has the power to move mountains. Our faith is in Him to do so. Nothing will be impossible for us (Matthew 17:20) because “nothing will be impossible with God” (Luke 1:37). This leads us to some wonderful news. We don’t have to summon up enough faith to perform miracles. It isn’t about believing hard enough, trying hard enough. We only need faith the size of a mustard seed. It is our God who performs mighty deeds.

What is your prayer life like? Has it grown stagnant? When we read, “For everyone that asks receives; and he that seeks finds, and to him that knock it shall be opened.” Luke 11:10. We are reminded that how we pray matters. We should pray diligently constantly making our hearts and requests known to God. When we ask, we shall receive. We should not just say the prayer and be finished, we should look for what God may be using to answer our prayers. When we seek, we shall find. Finally, after praying and seeking, we must continue seeking God without giving up. God will open the door.

In the next 3 months we will continue with the three ways your faith can move mountains.
