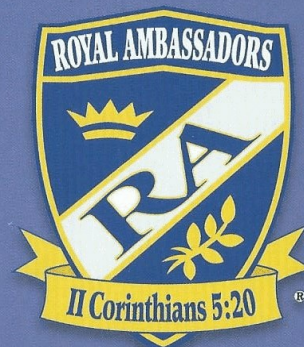

## “NEWS FROM OUR CHURCHES”
