



May issue trivia answers

Q: What is the official name for Buick Port Holes?

A: Cruise Air Vent Ports

Q: Who was the "Boss", as in the Boss 302 and Boss 429 Mustangs?

A: Bunkie Knudsen

Larry Shinoda chose the name "Boss" as a homage to his boss, Bunkie Knudsen, the former head of Pontiac.

Q: Starting with what model year did all US cars come equipped with dual master cylinder brake systems?

A: 1967

Federal law mandated dual master cylinders for 1967.

Q: What was the first mass-produced OHV V8?

A: The Oldsmobile Rocket

The Oldsmobile Rocket was the first mass-produced OHV V8 in 1949.

Q: The Chevy 409 is the bigger version of what engine?

A: 348

Q: When did Chrysler first officially use the "Hemi" name? A:1964

Even though Chrysler make engines with hemi heads in the 50s, it wasn't until 1964 when they revived the hemi head design and officially used the "Hemi" name.

Q: When did Chevrolet begin producing their famous small block engine?
A:1955

The first Chevy small block entered production in 1955, and had a displacement of 265 cubes.

Q: What model year did Pontiac's V8 debut?

A: 1955

In 1955 the 287 cubic inch "Strato Streak" V-8 was introduced.

Q: Why did the Mustang get bigger for 1971?

A: to hold a bigger engine
Bunkie Knudsen ordered the design of a
larger Mustang for 1971 in order to fit
Ford's beefy 429 ci Cobra Jet V8 under
the hood. By the time the '71 was introduced in September of 1970, the musclecar
market had collapsed due to increasing
insurance rates and increasing emission
regulations. Very few '71s were ordered
with the 429 engine.

Q: The decal on this Buick Nailhead says "Wildcat 445". What is 445?

A: Torque in ft-lbs

Q: Speaking of American torque, are you aware of Chevy's first 427? It was called the Z11 (a stroked 409), advertised at 430 HP & 435 ft# torque (some were as high as 650HP). 13.5:1 compression and dual 4 barrels. How many were built?

A: 50 in 1963

Only 50 were built, and sold to a select few

big names.

Q: In what model year did Pontiac start using the split grille and the arrowhead emblem? A: 1959

Q: What model year(s) was the "California Special" edition of the Mustang available? A: 1968

1968 was the only year for the "California Special".

Q: What model year did Pontiac's Tri-Power (3-2 bbl carbs) become available?

Q: When did Chrysler make their first (automotive) engine with hemispherical combustion chambers?

A: 1951

Chrysler's first OHV V8, made in 1951, was a hemi. It was 331 ci and produced 180 HP.

Q: What is the last year for Pontiac tripower?

A: 1966

Q: How many horsepower did the original Chrysler 300 make, and when was it introduced? A: 300 HP in 1955

The Chrysler 300, introduced in 1955, was the most powerful production car in the US.
