Chrysalis – Sunday, September 1st

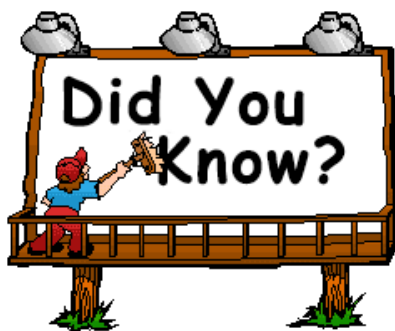
Men's- Saturday, September 7th

- Chrysalis registration will be from 7-7:30am EST on Saturday August 31st with send off at 8am, candlelight will be Sunday, September 1st at 8:30 pm and closing Monday, September 2nd at 5pm EST.
- Chrysalis flight # 54 has 6 boys and 9 girls. Men's walk # 125 has 19 men and women's walk # 136 is full. The deadline for applications for the men's walk is Wednesday, August 28th. We have already began a list for Spring 2020 for the women's walk.
- Registration for men's and women's walk will begin at 6pm EST. The meal will begin at 7pm and send off will be at 8pm. Men's send off will be Thursday, September 5th and women's is Thursday, September 12th.
- Closing ceremony will begin at on Sunday at 5PM EST for the flights / walks.
- Smoking is only allowed in designated area when on the mountain. This is a camp rule. We are guest so we ask that this rule be respected and followed. The designated area is behind the pavilion. Please do not smoke at the kitchen area or at the pavilion area. Everyone (even those who have not attended a 3 day event) are welcome to come to closing and to monthly gatherings.
- Please remember that if you are working a walk that team fees (\$90) are due prior to going on the mountain to work. This can be paid online on our website. Be sure to include what you are paying for in the note area.
- If you would like to serve on the Spring Chrysalis flight, you may go ahead and fill out our application as team selection for this will be September 14th. You may fill out an application to work on our new online links as well.
