

Chrysalis COVID Safety Guidelines

The Chrysalis Community is committed to serve, inspire and protect our workers and participants on this flight. Guidelines for COVID protection can be found by clicking [here](#). Please keep the community in prayer that we will be guided by God in preparation for this flight and throughout the Chrysalis weekend.

Lay directors, assistant lay directors, board representatives, area coordinators, logistic team, and guardian angels will be in charge of making sure participants and workers are adhering to the following guidelines.

- Registrar and assistants will conduct temperature checks for everyone as workers, participants and sponsors arrive. Outside area coordinators and assistant lays from each conference room will conduct morning temperature checks.
- Sanitizing will take place each time a group leaves any area.
- Everyone will be required to wear masks when 6 ft apart social distancing is not possible.
- We will have a designated area in case someone needs to be quarantined because of temperature or any begin showing COVID symptoms until we can make arrangements for them to be taken home.
- Beds will be set up 6 at least ft apart
- Restroom rotations will be made by table leaders and area coordinators so distancing is enforced in restrooms.
- All food preparers and servers will wear masks and gloves during the handling of food.
- Individual bottled waters will be provided in conference rooms and sleeping quarters.
- Dining room will be arranged for social distancing while eating.
- Sanitizing stations, along with extra masks, will be set up in every area.
- All Community Services will be set up for distancing. If socializing prior to a service and cannot maintain a distance of 6 feet apart, masks must be worn. Guidelines for each service will be explained in the Sponsor Letters and as the Community arrives to the services.
- All participants and workers must sign an acknowledgement of receipt of these guidelines and a liability waiver statement about the possibility of COVID contact located on the bottom of your medical form to be able to attend this Chrysalis flight.

*If you feel you cannot abide by these guidelines for any reason, we suggest that you postpone participating in or working a flight until these guidelines are no longer needed.
