## Flexible Instruction Day School Work Third Grade April 20-24

As much as I would love to see the kids every day, circumstances have caused the regular school day to change for a period of time. With this happening I am asking for your help to continue your child's growth academically. Below are the guidelines to follow. I kept them to the most important skills we need to keep growing.

Try to stick to a routine. Carve out a time during the normal hours of the school day to have your child complete these tasks. It should only take them 1-1 1/2 hours to complete. You know your child and if they can handle it all in one sitting. We transition between things throughout the day, so sitting for the entire time might be tough for most.

These are the requirements built around the Pennsylvania Department of Education guidelines to count attendance for the school day. I have also included links on my webpage if you are looking for other ways to keep your child engaged during this time away from school.

The story this week is an excerpt from the book Sarah Plain and Tall. The genre is historical fiction. While the children are reading the story I would like them to see how their everyday lives are different from the two children in the story.
