Dear Contestant:

The members of the Krotz Springs Sportsmen's Heritage Festival Association invite you to compete for the title of 2020 Krotz Springs Sportsmen's Heritage Festival Teen /Miss Queen. The KS Sportsmen's Heritage Queens travel across our great state as representatives of our festival. Our 2020 Miss Queen will participate in the Louisiana Association of Fairs and Festival's Queen's pageant in 2021.

*The Krotz Springs Sportsmen's Heritage Festival Miss Queen's pageant is open to single women between the ages of 16-22. Contestants MUST be 17 years old by January 1, 2021.

*The Krotz Springs Sportsmen's Heritage Festival Teen Queen's pageant is open to young ladies between the ages of 13-16.

To be a contestant you must: 1) be a resident of the state of Louisiana, 2) have never been married, nor have a child, 3) must not be serving as a contracted Queen of any other Fair or Festival, or be a past State Queen. If selected as Sportsmen's Heritage Queen, you may not compete for any other title except LAFF Queen. The contestant must be of good moral character and must always conduct herself in a lady-like manner. Our Queen must be willing to attend all fairs and festivals listed in the Krotz Springs Heritage Festival Queen's Agreement.

The contest is scheduled for Saturday, May 2, 2020 at 4:00 P.M. at the Krotz Springs Community Center, located at 216 Park Street in Krotz Springs, LA 70750. To enter, please complete and return the entry form with your \$100.00 entry fee for Miss Queen or the \$75.00 entry fee for Teen Queen to the address above by April 25th.

A "Queen's Agreement" outlining the rules and regulations by which the Krotz Springs Heritage Festival Queen must abide by is available on the festival website and should be read before deciding to participate in the Queens' competitions. Attached you will find the official pageant itinerary. Teen and Miss Contestants are required to be present at all events listed on the pageant itinerary, unless stated otherwise.

Please understand that neither the KSSHFA, nor the Town of Krotz Springs will be held responsible for the loss of any personal belongings nor for any accidents or illnesses that may occur while you are in Krotz Springs for pageant activities.
