**Where:** Live online via Zoom - link will be provided upon registration

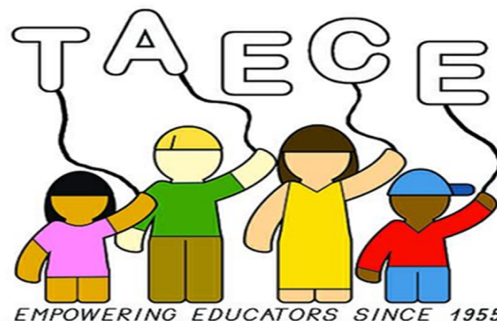
**Cost:** TAECE members: Free
