# New Center and Individual Membership Opportunities for the 2021-2022 Academic Year

TAECE is excited to announce new Center and Individual Membership Opportunities beginning August 1st. An Individual Membership is paid for by a single person and is

considered a qualified member according to our By-Laws. Individuals can include early childhood staff, teachers (current or retired), directors, professors, and college students. The Individual Membership is non-transferrable and follows the member wherever he/she is employed. A Center Membership is purchased by the center's director who pays for a block of memberships that coincides with the number of staff at a discounted rate. The director receives a membership card for each staff member denoting the name of the center, the number of people paid for, and the staff member's name. The staff member is considered a qualified member according to our By-Laws. Since the center holds the membership, if an individual staff member leaves the center's employment, the membership is transferred to the new staff hire at the center's request. Take a look at TAECE.net this summer to find membership applications and our low-cost membership options. Annual membership runs from August 1, 2021 to July 31st, 2022.

## CPR/First Aid and Other Health Related Trainings Coming This Fall!

Each year we partner with Al Materia of EMTA Enterprises to provide high quality childcare specific health trainings at a low cost to you. The 2021-2022 school year is no exception. We usually offer two dates for the trainings, one in August and one in September, to obtain the state required CPR/First Aid, Daily Health, OSHA, Playground Safety, and Recognizing Child Abuse and Neglect trainings.
