**RESOLUTIONS**  
**JANUARY 26, 2016**

In accordance with Sections 6.2 of the Declaration of Covenants, Restrictions, Rights, Affirmative Obligations and Conditions (the “Declarations”), at its January 26, 2016, regular meeting, the Board of Directors of the Oak Park Civic Association, Inc. (the “Board”) reaffirmed flag restrictions previously established by the Design Committee. The intention of such restrictions is to maintain the standard of appearance of Oak Park consistent with a high quality development by restricting the appearance, size, and location of flags erected or maintained on the Exterior of any Improvement on any Lot to the extent permitted by law, including § 55-513.1 of the Code of Virginia which allows associations to establish reasonable restrictions as to the size, place, duration, and manner of placement or display of the flag on such property.

**RESOLVED:** To reaffirm the guideline previously established by the Design Committee that only one (1) flag attached to a pole not longer than six (6) feet and which itself is attached to a dwelling as it faces the front yard is permitted on a Lot.
