

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

The undersigned incorporator, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, hereby certifies:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Jacob's Cove Management Group, Inc

ARTICLE II Period of Duration

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III Purpose

The corporation has been organized for the following purposes:

ARTICLE VII Limitation of Liability

Each director, in consideration for his services, shall, in the absence of fraud, be indemnified, whether then in office or not, for the reasonable costs and expenses incurred by him in connection with the defense of, or for advice concerning any claim asserted or proceeding brought against him by reason of his being or having been a director, stockholder or officer of the corporation or of any subsidiary of the corporation, whether or not wholly owned, to the maximum extent permitted by law. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be inclusive of any other rights to which any director may be entitled as a matter of law.

ARTICLE VIII Members

The Corporation shall have one class of members, which shall consist of all of the owners of the lots of real property which are a part of the following:

the Jacob's Cove Subdivision, as described in the plat recorded in Plat Book 39, Page 31, in the Probate Records of Madison County, Alabama; for the Jacob's Cove Subdivision, Phase Two, as described in the plat recorded in Plat Book 41, Page 51, in the Probate Records of Madison County, Alabama; for the Jacob's Cove Subdivision, Phase Three, as described in the plat recorded in Plat Book 44, Page 55, in the Probate Records of Madison County, Alabama; and for the Jacob's Cove Subdivision, Phase Four, as described in the plat recorded in Plat Book 45, Page 94, in the Probate Records of Madison County, Alabama.

ARTICLE IX Other Provisions

- (a) The corporation shall have all powers granted corporations under the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, which shall specifically include, but not be limited to, the power to:
 - (1) Borrow money and secure the same by a mortgage or security interest in any or all of its real or personal property.
 - (2) Do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes of the corporation or in furtherance of any of the powers of the corporation, either alone or in partnership, general or limited, with other corporations, firms or individuals, provided the same shall not be in violation of the laws of the State of Alabama.
- (b) Action of the directors may be taken by unanimous written consent without meeting and it shall have the same effect as the unanimous

vote of the directors.

(c) The By-laws of the corporation may not be amended or repealed except upon a two-third's majority vote of the members.
