

2013 PIT Survey Overview

New River Valley Housing Partnership

40 Surveys

- 40% Male, 60% Female
- 3% Hispanic
- 13% Black, 78% White, 5% Asian/Pacific Islander, 5% Other
- 43% victim of domestic violence
- 3% unsheltered, 90% in homeless shelter, 8% in other homeless situation
- The length of homelessness is the following:
 - 3% a week or less
 - 30% more than a week but less than a month
 - 13% one to 3 months
 - 45% more than 3 months, but less than a year
 - 10% one year or longer
- The primary reason for homelessness is the following:
 - 13% disability
 - 23% unemployment
 - 10% underemployment
 - 5% eviction
 - 6% substance abuse
 - 3% dual diagnosis
 - 43% domestic violence
- 55% were individuals, 5% couple (without children), 33% single parent households, 5% two- parent households
- The following disabilities were reported:
 - 8% alcohol/drugs
 - 33% mental illness
 - 10% physical disabilities
- 73% unemployed, 28% employed
- 10% less than high school, 10% some high school (no diploma), 47% high school diploma or GED, 30% some college, 3% college degree
- 3% have served on active duty in US Armed Services
