

2015 PITC Survey Overview

38 surveys

- 56% female, 44% male
- 8% Hispanic
- 20% Black, 73% White
- 92% Sheltered, 8% unsheltered
- The length of homelessness:
 - 13% less than a week
 - 45% less than 3 months
 - 21% less than 1 year
 - 13% more than a year
 - 13% refused
- The primary reason for homelessness
 - 26% Domestic violence
 - 3% Mental Illness
 - 5% Substance Abuse
 - 0% Disability
 - 21% Unemployed
 - 18% Underemployed
 - 11% Eviction
 - 0% Dual diagnosis
 - 11% Did not answer
- 42% Individuals, 29% Single parent household; 5% Two parent household; 2% couples
- The following disabilities were identified
 - 3% Mental Illness
 - 0% Alcohol
 - 2% Substance abuse2
 - 2% physical disabilities
 - 0% long-term diagnosed illness (cancer, etc.)
- 50% employed, 21% unemployed, 29% unknown
- 4% less than high school, 4% some high school, 30% high school/GED, 18% some college, and 2% college degree, remainder unknown
- 0% served active duty in the US Armed Forces
- With the following ages
 - 34% below 18 yrs of age,
 - 5% 18- 24,
 - 58% 25 or older,
 - 3% unknown
