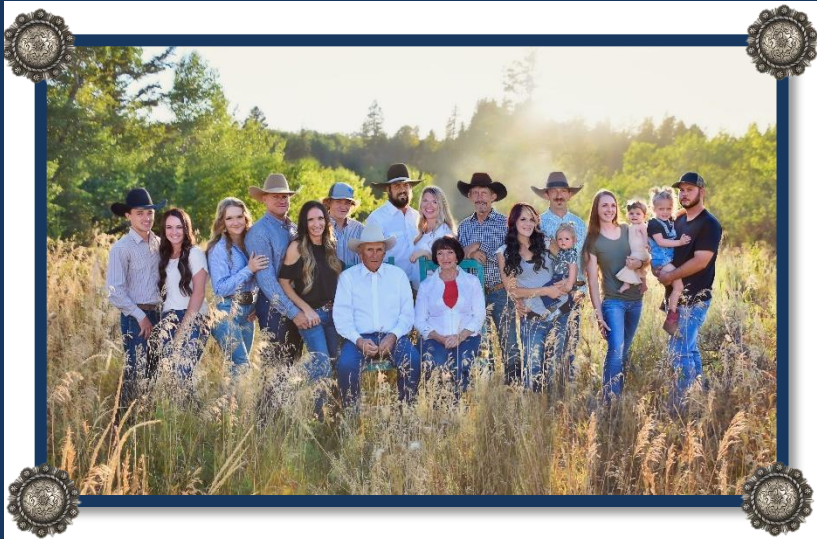

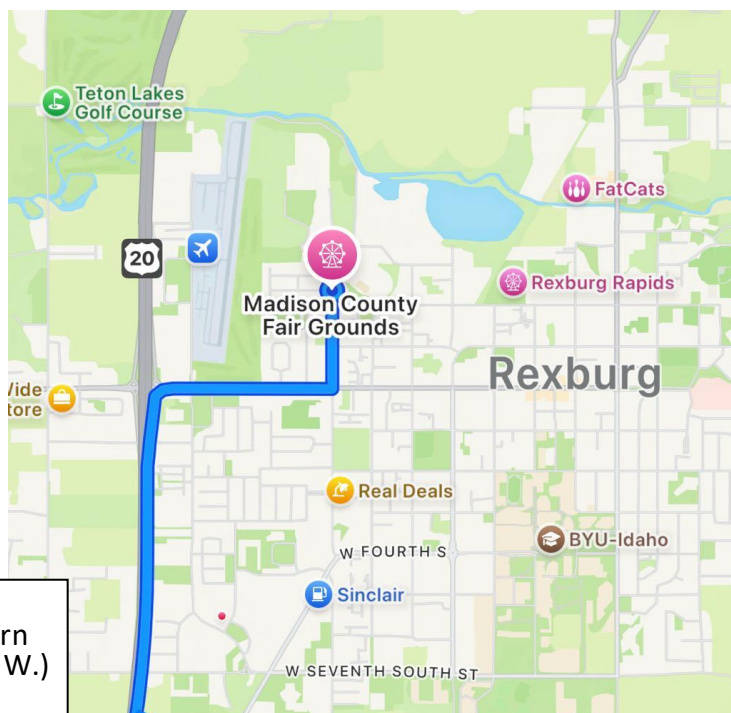

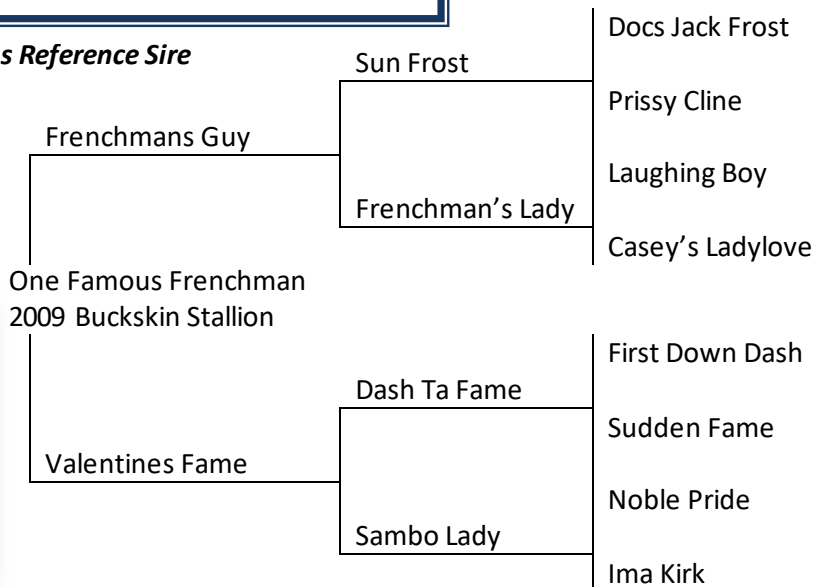

Munns Reference Sire

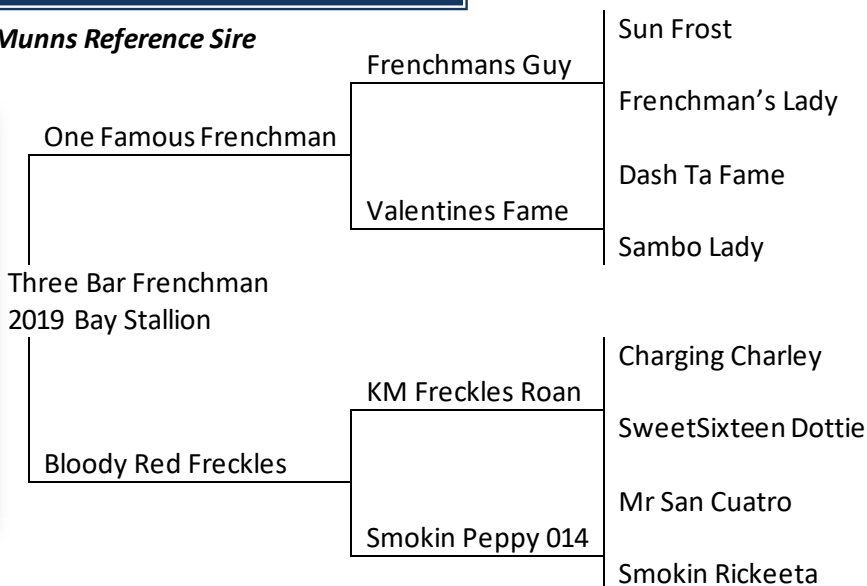


We feel so fortunate to have *One Famous Frenchman* as a member of our breeding program. We really like what a little running blood added to our working horses is doing for our breeding program. The *One Famous Frenchman* colts that we have had a chance to ride so far are smart, talented, and eager to please! They are pretty and most are up on legs a little more than our other colts. They have an elegant look and are pretty movers as well. They are light footed, athletic type horses that are very trainable. The more of them we ride, the more impressed we are. They are just consistently GOOD colts.

One Famous Frenchman is a big, pretty individual with good muscling and as keen a head as you will ever find on a *Dash Ta Fame* bred horse. He is a very unique color too... An ever-changing golden buckskin to nearly black at times. He has a big full mane and tail and an overall striking presence. He was in training with Kelly Conrado to futurity and was injured as a 4 year old. That changed the course of his career as he had to have a year off. When he healed, they started heading steers on him and made the decision to pursue that direction. He has unlimited potential any direction you want to go, lots of run, very cowy, athletic, but most of all SO GOOD MINDED and trainable. He has spent the past several years in Charly's string. 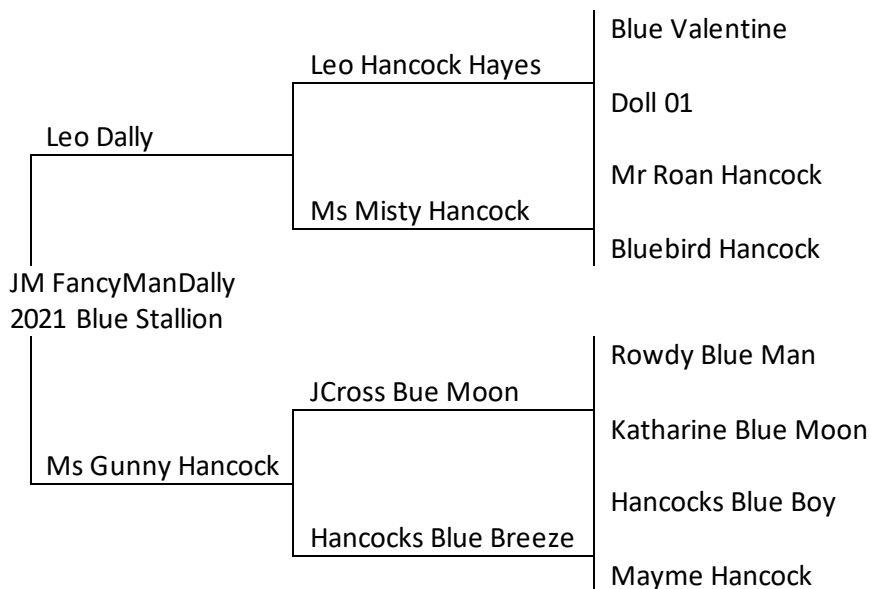

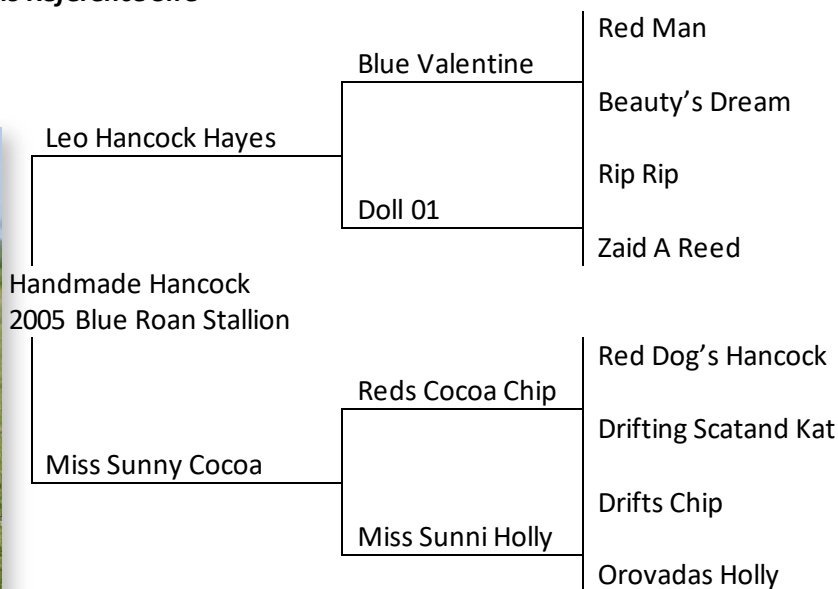

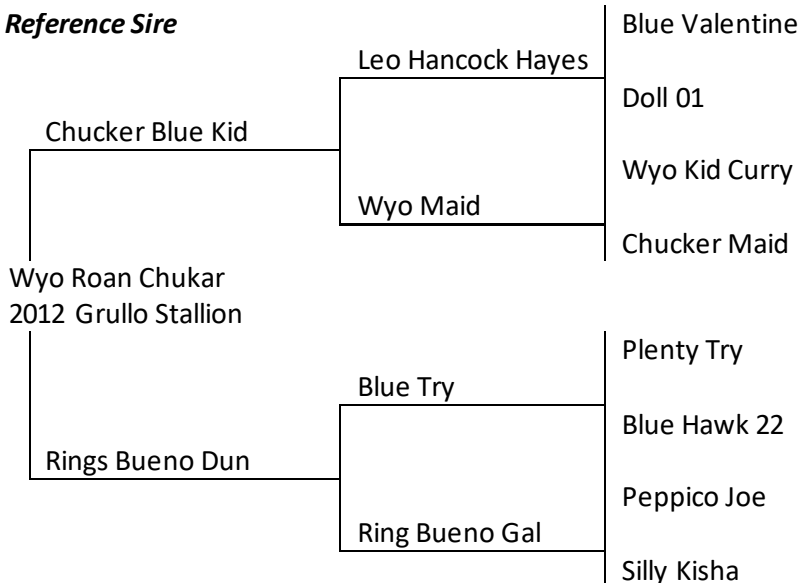

Metrona Cat

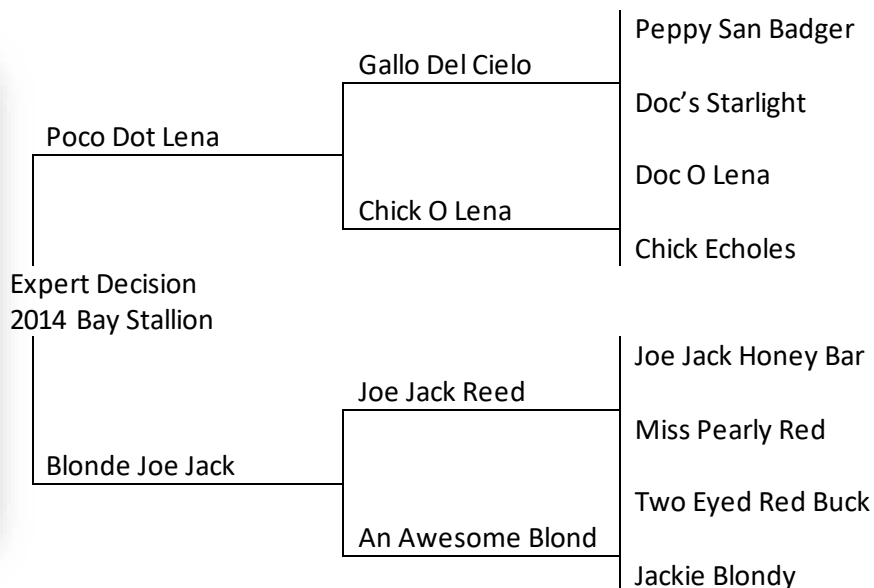

Metrona Cat aka *Jackson* is kind of our Cinderella story... in December of 2020 we bought this common looking sorrel stud colt that was a reject out of a cutting program. In March of 2021 I took him to CA and left him with Jared Jones to see what he "felt in him". It wasn't 2 weeks and he called and told us we better buy a Futurity Slot because this colt was legit! 7 months later we owned an NRCHA Futurity Finalist. Thanks to Jared's talent and dedication, as well as *Jackson's* ability and trainability they have a little over 35k in Open NRCHA earnings. Due to his show career we have not bred many mares to him yet, but he has a few babies on the ground with the oldest being yearlings, so we are excited to get to ride a couple soon. So far they sure are pretty headed! We had him home this spring which allowed us to get more mares bred to him. We will get a pretty good sample in 2026! Our plain little reject turned into a gorgeous deep cherry chestnut with a big strong hind quarter, a baby doll head, adequate bone, and a classy presence that makes you know he is special. Charly has big plans for him in the upcoming years, she showed him in the JH cow horse this year and he was awesome to meet her at her level and was a perfect gentleman for her to show... Jared Jones will be taking him to the **Worlds Greatest Horseman** in February 2026 as well as a few other Open NRCHA shows, so he has plenty left to accomplish!

Expert Decision

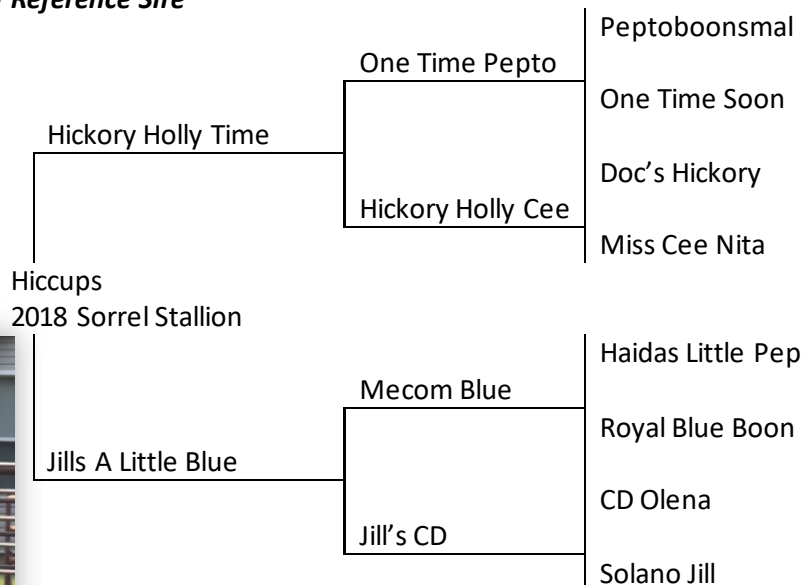
Shiner Reference Sire

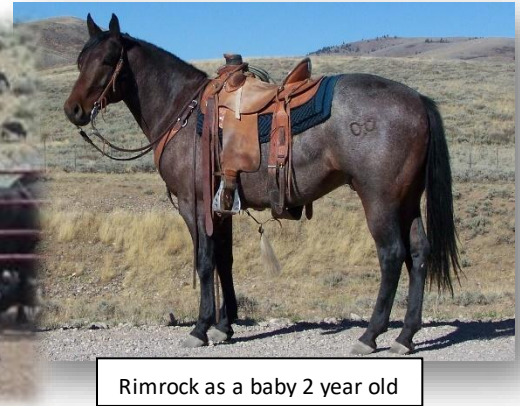

The good minded kind that will ride off with no fuss, regardless of the time of year and go do about any job. We branded on him and heeled on him a little too. He was very cowy, intelligent, and really willing with a big stop. We liked his conformation as well. He was a nice headed horse with a good hip, dark solid feet, and was well balanced. Out of a double bred *High Rolling Roany* daughter. We feel that his colts are having a big impact on our horse program. They are very very trainable, big hearted and they care about pleasing you. They want to work with you and are well rounded horses that can go about any direction. They are making rope horses for sure! Breanna had a young *Rimrock* mare out of a *Blue Bird* daughter that she lost to colic. She was one of the special kind that gave 110% every time with plenty of talent to go along with her try. She was cowy, fast, and a big stopper. Besides being gorgeous!! Good training is a big part of a success like this, but natural ability certainly plays a big role as well. It takes a long time to really replace that kind... if you ever do. After that mare died, Bre took a full sister and made another one that is just as good. That doesn't happen very often!! They are pretty special for sure! *Rimrock* died last fall. It seems like you never full appreciate the special ones until they are gone! We do have a pretty fancy stud prospect that we kept back, so we will see how he rides, in hopes that he might earn his spot as a replacement, *Rimrock* will be missed just the same! 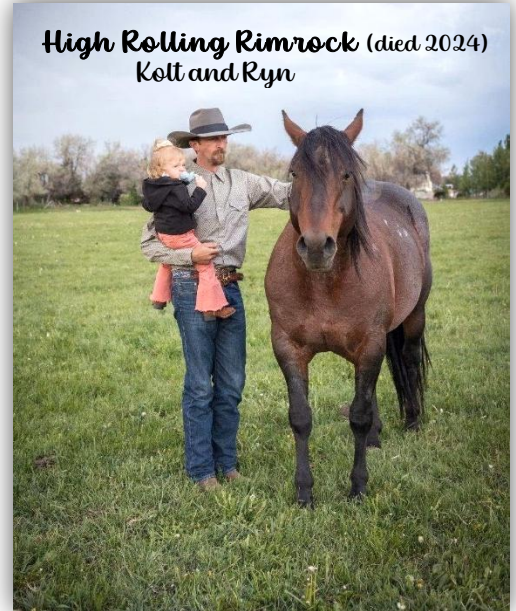
