SCHEDULE UPDATE

October 7 and October 22 gymkhana will be optional double point days. Riders can pick either day to be double points but not both. When signing up, you will need to notate on your entry form if you are riding for double points and pay two entry fees. Riders can qualify for awards with 10 individual days or 9 individual days including 1 double point day.
