In October the team will compete in the Grand National Rodeo at Cow Palace.

The Grand National Rodeo hosted at the famous, Cow Palace, is one of the largest rodeo events in the United States. Since opening in 1941, the Cow Palace has welcomed over 50 million visitors through its doors. The arena got its unique name from a local newspaper that asked, "Why, when people are starving, should money be spent on a "palace for cows?" Then a headline writer turned the phrase around, hence the origin of the world famous name.

The Cow Palace was built to host the first Grand National Rodeo, then known as three separate events: the Grand National Livestock Exposition, the Grand National Horse Show, and the Grand National Rodeo, held simultaneously from November 15–22, 1941. Further events at the Cow Palace were interrupted temporarily by World War II, and the site was used to stage troops; the ten-day rodeo and associated events returned on November 15, 1946.

The Spurs N' Lace Drill Team will complete on Saturday, October 14th. The competition will start at 8am and the winners will ride in the rodeo at 6pm.
