Mounted Shooting Practice May 19th 9am-1pm SJVR Arena

Guns, cowgirls, cowboys and horses it doesn't get more exciting than that! Mounted Shooting is a fast growing sport that appeals to many riders. Like any new discipline, it's important you take the time to properly learn the ins and outs. Mounted shooting has loud sounds and popping balloons, so your horse will definitely need some training before you jump in.

Training a Horse for Mounted Shooting

How do they handle the environment? A good mounted shooting horse needs to be okay with loud sounds. You'll want to get a feel for this before you start a run. Try a dry run. Trot your horse through the pattern and shoot the gun, but without any bullets. It'll give you both an idea of what to expect. Follow a trained horse. Go slow at a trot and follow behind a seasoned horse as the rider shots and pops balloons. Then, shoot with a seasoned horse nearby. Now's your turn, but make sure to have a pro next to you for support. Find Knowledgeable Help Come out to a SJVR Mounted Shooting practice and get help from the experienced instructors like Lisa

Mission Peak to Del Valle Pack In Camping Trail Ride

Three Days & Two Nights

30 miles – 7500 ft elevation gain

Schedule:

Saturday, May 25, 2024

- 9AM Leave Lathrop -10AM Get dropped off at trail head at Mission Peak
 - Ride approximately 10 miles
 - Night 1 Camping with Group Dinner
 - Sunday, May 26, 2024
 - Ride approximately 10 miles
 - Night 2 Camping with Group Dinner
 - Monday, May 27, 2024
 - Ride approximately 10 miles to Del Valle Regional Park
 - At approximately 5pm get picked up.

Trail route can be viewed on AllTrails.com:

"Del Valle to Ohlone College via Rose Peak, Sunol, Mission Peak"

Meals will cost approximately \$40/pp.

REQUIREMENTS: You must pack in all your own personal items, drinks, bedding, etc. You must provide your own horse and transportation. You will need non-riding

drivers to drop riders and horses off at Mission Peak and to pick riders and horses up in Del Valle. Once leaving Sunol, there is no place to leave for 20 miles, so horses and riders must be in good physical shape.

If you wish to do a day trail ride, you could ride from Mission Peak to Sunol (10 miles). You will need to arrange your own pick up in Sunol.
