## TEACH US TO PRAY

- 1 Prayer is a solemn request for \_\_\_\_\_ or expression of thanks addressed to God. It is the act of talking and \_\_\_\_\_ to God. ....that they ought always to \_\_\_\_\_ and not lose heart. (Luke 18:1)
- 2 Preparation for \_\_\_\_\_ is always with a spirit of prayer. (Nehemiah 8:1-3)
- 3 Things shift and move in the \_\_\_\_\_ when God's people begin to pray. "Thus the LORD was moved by prayer for the land..." (2 Samuel 24:25; 2 Chronicles 7:14)
- 4 Our highest \_\_\_\_\_ as Christians and children of God is to PRAY!

R- \_\_\_\_\_ of your sins  
A- \_\_\_\_\_ for yourself and others  
Y- \_\_\_\_\_ yourself to the will of God
- 6 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "Today if you hear His voice, do not \_\_\_\_\_ your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness..." (Hebrews 3:7-8)
- 7 We have prayed to a \_\_\_\_\_ God with yesterday's prayers.  
We have prayed to a \_\_\_\_\_ God for future prayers.  
God is saying I am a \_\_\_\_\_ God and I am asking for you to seek me TODAY, right now!
