Expressive painting with oils



This is a 2-day workshop spread over 2 consecutive Sundays which will allow for drying time of oil paint enabling students to work in stages on their painting.

During this course you will be introduced to some of the techniques used by the artist Joanne Reed in her expressive painting style. Learning will focus on various ways of using oil paint, mixing colour and how to use colour to create atmosphere and feeling within your painting, perspective and expressive mark making.

We will be working within the stunning Andromeda gardens making some energetic sketches and looking at composition before returning to the studio to begin developing a more in-depth painting on canvas from our sketches and photographs created in the gardens.

Joanne will be giving individual attention to all students helping them to overcome obstacles and giving guidance to improve and enhance your painting skills. Don't worry if you are relatively new to painting this course is suitable to all abilities and will be tailored towards each student's individual ability.
