If you are a new student, I will supply your initial music and assignment book. Returning students must purchase their other books.



### **Music Contract**

- Lessons are scheduled for 30-45 minutes each week depending on the age and maturity of the student.
- Homework assignments are expected to be completed and reviewed at each lesson.
- Students are expected to practice daily for at least 15 minutes each day. It is always apparent when a student has not practiced.
- The instructor will notify you by text, email or phone call if there is a need to reschedule a lesson
- Covid protocols- Please do not attend your lesson if you are ill. Unvaccinated students must wear a mask. The piano and lesson area will be thoroughly cleaned in between each lesson. An air purifier system will be on throughout your lesson.
- > There will be a winter break of three weeks and lessons are finished at the end of the school year.
- A music recital is scheduled for June, 2023 for all students.
- The instructor will seek out other opportunities for student performances during the year.



# Costs and Cancellations Procedures

The cost of lessons are:

\$35.00 - 30 minute lesson

\$ 40.00- 45 minute lesson

Parents are expected to sit in on the first lesson (new student only)

Monthly payments will be collected at the beginning of the month. Clients will receive an invoice via email.

There is a 10% discount given for siblings.

You must call at least 24 hours in advance if you are unable to keep your lesson time. Any notice received less than 24 hours will result in a charge for the missed lesson

A student will be dropped from the program for three consecutive missed lesson without prior notice by the student.

Payment is expected when services are rendered. There will be a \$10.00 charge for a returned check.
