5. (Ten) Hail Mary's, The Our Father, Glory Be and The Fatima Prayer - do this for each of the five mysteries.

## The Fatima Prayer

Oh, my Jesus, forgive us for our sins and
lead all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of thy mercy. Amen.
6. After the fifth mystery and its prayers say the Hail Holy Queen.

## Hail Holy Queen

Hail, Holy Queen, mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this, our exile
show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

Pray for us, O Holy Mother of GOD that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

3. The Nativity (birth) of our Lord Jesus Christ
4. The Presentation of Jesus in the temple
5. Finding 12 year old Jesus in the temple

The Sorrowful Mysteries (prayed on Tuesday and Friday)

1. The agony in the garden
2. The scourging at the pillar
3. Jesus is crowned with thorns
4. Jesus carries the cross.
5. The crucifixion and death of our Lord Jesus

## To Recite the Rosary:

1. First say the Apostle's creed

## Apostle's Creed

I believe in God , the Father almighty, Creator of Heaven and Earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord.
He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into Hell. On the third day He rose again.
