

5. Say The Our Father, Ten Hail Mary's, the Glory Be, and The Fatima Prayer - do this for each of the five mysteries.

6. After the fifth mystery and it's prayers say

Hail Holy Queen

Hail, Holy Queen, mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this, our exile show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God.....
that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

7. **Recite the Rosary Prayer:** Let us Pray;
O God, whose only begotten Son, by his life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal salvation. Grant, we beseech thee, that while meditating on the on these mysteries of the most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, that we may both imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

8. **Say: For the intentions of the Holy father...**
Recite one – Our Father, one, Hail Mary and One Glory Be.
– Sign of the cross - completed

2. You shall not take God's name in vain.

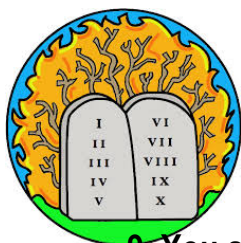
Do Not Curse or swear

Glorious Mysteries

(prayed on Wednesday and Sunday)

1. The resurrection of Jesus
2. The Ascension of Jesus to Heaven
3. The descent of the Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit)
4. The Assumption of Mary into Heaven
5. Mary is crowned as Queen of Heaven and Earth

The Luminous Mysteries

(prayed on Thursday)

1. The Baptism in the Jordan River
2. The wedding at Cana
3. The proclamation of the kingdom
4. The transfiguration of Jesus
5. The institution of the Holy Eucharist



To Recite the Rosary:

1. First say the: Apostle's Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of Heaven and Earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into Hell. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into Heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God, the Father almighty. He will come a gain to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

2. Say the: Lord's Prayer (Our Father)

3. Say three Hail Mary's: (for the virtues of faith, Hope and Charity), followed by The Glory Be and the Our Father.

4. Announce one the 5 mysteries (in order) to be meditated upon as you pray the decade.
