

PROPHETIC WORDS GIVEN AT ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL

These words were given at Alton Day of Renewal, and we believe they are from the Lord. We hope you find them inspiring, encouraging, or comforting. Although we have discerned that they are in line with the teaching of the Church, please bear in mind that "Private revelations.... do not belong to the deposit of faith. It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history." (CCC67)

ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL WORDS OF PROPHECY 28/11/20

First Word

1John 2:20 You have been anointed by the Holy One and all of you have knowledge. And to know how to apply this go to vs 27: but as His anointing teaches us about all things and is true and is not a lie, and just as He has taught you, abide in Him.

Second word

During the quiet time I had, similar to the previous word "Spend quality time with me," says the Lord. *Isaiah 45: I am the Lord your God and beside me there is no other. "Even in your old age I am he. Even to grey hairs I will carry you. I have made you and I will bear you. Even I will carry and deliver you says the Lord."*

Third word

Zephaniah 3:14-18 Sing, O daughter of Zion; shout aloud, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! ...on that day they will say to Jerusalem 'Do not fear O Zion, do not let your hands hang limp. The Lord your God is with you, He is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing. The sorrows from the appointed feasts I will remove from you'.

Jeremiah 33:10-11 This is what the Lord says: 'You say about this place, "It is a desolate waste, without people or animals." Yet in the towns of Judah and the streets of Jerusalem that are deserted, inhabited by neither people nor animals, there will be heard once more the sounds of joy and gladness, the voices of bride and bridegroom, and the voices of those who bring thank offerings to the house of the Lord, saying, "Give thanks to the Lord Almighty, for the Lord is good; his love endures forever." For I will restore the fortunes of the land as they were before,' says the Lord.

I got the sense that God has got us in all of this: we've got to retain the attitude of thanksgiving that He never changes. Yes, we're all being shaken up but remain steadfast in our faith because He doesn't change and we can still be joyful and keep our eyes focussed on the heavenly gifts and that promise that never changes. And we can draw other people into that vision of His promise for His people.

Fourth word

I had a picture of Jesus wearing a crown and kingly robes. He showed me a gold signet ring that he was wearing on the little finger of his left hand. Then I watched as he moved his hand, seeing the ring glittering as it moved with him, obedient to his every move as it had no power of its own. He then turned to me and said, "You will be my signet ring!"

“My beloved ones, although you are in the world, you are not of the world for you belong to me. Before you were born, I called you and set you aside for this time. As citizens and heirs to the Kingdom I am calling you to be my Ambassadors for the Kingdom of God. Will you answer my call? Will you be my light in this time of gathering darkness? Are you willing to stand up for the truth of my Gospel in a world that is in slavery to lies and deceits? Where hatred and injustice reigns will you be an Ambassador for my love & mercy? Do not be afraid to answer my call, for I will always be at your side; I will lead you in the way of love and strengthen you for the task.

My special ones, I am calling you into a deeper level of holiness. Will you open up your hearts and minds to receive the power and authority that I have reserved for you, in this hour? Are you willing to surrender to me more deeply? Then you will move when I move, and do as you see me do, for you will be as my signet ring, signed with the signature of Jesus and sealed with the Holy Spirit. Mighty will be the decrees of the kingdom that will flow from your lips, anything you ask you will receive and great will be the harvest of souls for the Kingdom of Heaven.

When I asked for confirmation, I opened my bible at random to these words from Haggai: *“On that day, declares the Lord Almighty, I will take you my servant declares the Lord, and I will make you like my signet ring, for I have chosen you, declares the Lord Almighty” (Haggai 2:5)*

Fifth word

Rejoice in me and be glad. I am the king of martyrs. I will give you strength and perseverance to endure. Stay awake and pray that the Church will be one.

Sixth word

I can confirm both of those because I had: I am the king; I sit in judgment and my justice will prevail. The time is coming when you will be recognised as my servant. Do not be afraid, I am with you. You speak with my words, you will move with my action. I will be with you every step of the way. I will guide you in all that you do. Trust in me.

Seventh word

I can confirm what you said about do not be afraid, as this is what I had: *MY peace I give you; do not let your hearts be troubled. Do not be afraid. (John 14:27)* I come to you today to renew you, to fill you with my peace and with every blessing. I will enter deep into your heart if you will open it to me.

Eighth word

I sensed the Lord saying in that quiet time that there are many voices saying things like ‘this is going to be a Christmas like no other Christmas,’ and it’s coming over like prophets of doom. But I sense the Lord saying: I want you to take this as a prophetic word from me, a call from me to make this a Christmas like no other Christmas. A Christmas of celebrating my birth and my reign as king. And a call for making it not just a Christmas like no other Christmas but a time of preparation – an Advent like no other Advent. I sense that some of these words that have been spoken the Lord wants us to hear as a real call from Him to make this a really special and unique Christmas through our love and concern and the way we prepare and whatever we do in this Christmas season.

Ninth word

As we went into Adoration I saw a flicker of our blessed Mother and she was holding Jesus and it reminded me of the fragility and the vulnerability of a baby. Yesterday in Portsmouth Diocese there was a day of prayer, fasting and adoration 24 hours and we kept going back for adoration, it was a really blessed time. And this morning at 7.30 there was a short Benediction and during this time I just experienced a profound love of God but also a profound love for our Church. A sense of belonging – this is my Church, my people, my community which God has called me into. This is from Psalm 95 *For He is our God, we are the people He watches over, the sheep under His care.* And I had the sense of the Lord saying: ‘Yes, I know that sometimes it seems like you are climbing a steep hill but know that I am beside you; I will sustain and uphold you at all times.’

I don’t know about others but I’ve been having a really difficult time and those words and that experience this morning really encouraged me and sustained me and I want to give that to others. If you have that sense you are climbing a steep hill, that you’re pushing against all the anxieties of the world, to know that God is there sustaining and upholding us at this time. I really sense that He wants us to pray more, to spend more time with Him; to have more fasting and more Adoration. This way we will really persevere and push through as a Church for our community and also for the world. I believe that God is asking us to do this. Praise God!

Tenth word

There were several things being said this morning – you know how it works, the Lord says you ought to share something and you think, maybe or maybe not; if it’s confirmed again I’ll share it. And it has come up several times: ‘Rest in the deep assurance of my unfailing love. Let your body, mind and spirit relax in my presence. Release into my care anything that is troubling you, so that you can focus your full attention on me. Be aware of the vast dimensions of my love for you: wider, longer, higher, deeper than anything you can know. Rejoice that this marvellous love is yours forever. The best response to this glorious gift is a life steeped in thankfulness. Every time you thank me, you acknowledge that I am your Lord and provider: this is a proper stance for a child of God, receiving with thanksgiving. Bring me the sacrifice of gratitude and watch to see how much I will bless you.’

Eleventh word

I felt the Lord saying this: ‘At the moment you cannot move, at the moment you are confined. But just like batteries are still and confined but essential in a torch, I call upon you to provide the power for the torch of my Church. Hold up in prayer my servant Francis, the Cardinals, the Bishops, and the Priests, so that my light in them can shine clearly and bring hope to the world.’
