PROPHETIC WORDS GIVEN AT ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL

ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL WORDS OF PROPHECY 23/1/21

First Word

"To you all I say: These times we are in are times for rejoicing. So many poor souls are turning to me and finding strength and solace. You too delight to turn to me. In me you find all you need in these days: protection, help, support, and my goodness prevailing in your lives. I give you peace, I give you hope, I give you my love."

Second word

I had a picture of people standing with their luggage in a revolving glass door, similar to those at the entrance of many hotels. They seemed to be stuck, too afraid to step out and were going around and around within it. Then the Lord said:

"My children when you are afraid to come to me it grieves my heart. I am only one step away! Come my children, wherever you are, take the next step. I can't wait to meet with you; I can't wait to embrace you and to fill you with my love. Come my children, come just as you are! Take the next step and know that I love you.

Third word

Isaiah 5:26 He will raise a signal for a nation far away and whistle for a people at the end of the earth. Here they come swiftly, speedily.

Fourth word

People will come from far and wide to worship the Lord. They will meet and talk and much good will come from it. The world will unite even more than the pandemic has caused them to do. Climate change will be halted. Mankind will survive.

Fifth word

I am perfect love. Whatever experience you have had of love in your life is infinitely small compared with my love. And I give it to you freely: the price has already been paid by my Son Jesus, so you don't have to earn it – just receive. Believe and receive.

Sixth word

A few years ago our prayer group leader was having radiotherapy and it gave her a new way of looking at Adoration. She said we just come and sit in front of the Blessed Sacrament and it's like being in a kind of divine radiation and we can just ask the Lord to remove from us anything in us that doesn't give glory to Him.

Seventh word

I had a great sense of community with all of you – a sense that you're not on your own. It made me remember a few months ago when I was at a Lectio Divina and a passage came up: "Awesome God – you're awesome." And it took me all of a sudden into space, which I thought was going to be really scary, with people coming out of the shadows, but it wasn't anything like that. It was almost being within the Lord, within Himself. And it was just compassion. Love. Peace and everything that the Lord has that drew me into Him. Everywhere I went in space, it was the same amount of love and peace and joy – and that's for everyone. When I looked at myself, with the doubts, disappointments and everything within me, it made me realise that Jesus loved me in spite of who I am and what was within me. He just drew me in and it was so beautiful.

Eighth word

When I was gazing on the monstrance, there was a little catch holding the Blessed Sacrament and it reminded me of Atlas [in Greek mythology], whom Zeus had condemned to carrying the burden of the world on his shoulders. My train of thought was that, actually, we have the weight of the world on our shoulders. "Am I my brother's keeper?" It was coming to me from that Gospel reading [Matt 12:46-50] — it was about all of you are my brothers, my sisters, my family. We are our brother's keeper in this pandemic. What I was getting from what was being said, was that we all have our responsibility, we all have our share. There was talk about community, about love, about hope; that nations would come from afar, that people would turn to the Lord. But who is going to tell them, to show them, to share it with them unless it's ourselves that do it? So even in our small limited way in lockdown, within our own limited communication with family, with friends, through zoom meetings etc. we all have our part to play in sharing this love of God with all of those we interact with. Yes we are, in the name of God, our brother's keeper.

Ninth word

Psalm 111:1 Praise the Lord! I will thank the Lord with all my heart as I meet with His godly people.

Hebrews 6:10-12 God is not unfair- He will not forget how hard you have worked for Him and how you have shown your love to Him by caring for other Christians, as you still do. Our great desire is that you will keep right on loving others as long as life lasts, in order to make certain that what you hope for will come true. Then you will not become spiritually dull and indifferent; instead you will follow the example of those who are going to inherit God's promises because of their faith and patience.

The Lord gave me this lovely picture of snow and I could see leaves and branches through it but it was virgin snow – nobody had walked on it and it was so beautiful. And I sensed the Lord saying: "Enjoy your life; enjoy my creation." I think the Lord is trying to encourage us all, in spite of all that is going on in the world at this time, just to look to Him and enjoy all that He has given us. In spite of all the difficulties and the trials and tribulations, look to the Lord.

Tenth word

When the lady was talking about the revolving door and people stuck with their luggage in it, I immediately had this thought that the luggage is sin and their attachment to sin is keeping people away from God. We have to leave our attachment to sin and our attachment to the worldly life behind in order to come close to God

During exposition I had a picture. Jesus was walking across my lawn with open arms. I ran into his arms and he embraced me and held me. I then knelt at His feet and poured some of my precious perfume over them.
