READ THE SCRIPTURE VERSE AND TRY TO WORK OUT WHICH IS THE GIFT

- 1. Matthew 16: 23 Jesus to Peter "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do."
- 2. John 9 The man born blind. Jesus said "Neither he nor his parents sinned; it is so that the works of God might be made visible through him.
- 3. Luke 2: 36 Anna, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher..... she gave thanks to God and poke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem.
- 4. Mark 2: 5 "Son, your sins are forgiven." Now some of the scribes were sitting there, questioning in their hearts, "Why does this man speak like that? He is blaspheming! and immediately Jesus, perceiving in his spirit that they thus questioned within themselves, said ...
- 5. Matthew 16: 21 Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer greatly.
- 6. Matthew 8: 2 the leper "Lord, if you will, you can make me clean " Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him saying, "I will, be clean "
- 7. Luke 1: 46 And Mary said: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my saviour. For he has looked upon his handmaid's lowliness; behold, from now on will all ages call me blessed.
- 8. Matthew 5 Beatitudes "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 9. Mark 8: 8 They ate and were satisfied. They picked up the fragments left over-seven baskets. There were about four thousand people.
- 10. Luke 9: 18 Once when Jesus was praying in solitude, and the disciples were with him, he asked them, "Who do the crowds say that I am?" Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." Which gift? Jesus said to him in reply, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father
- 11. Luke 7: 6 the Centurion sent friends to tell him, "Lord, do not trouble yourself, for I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof.
- 12. John 1: 35 and as he watched Jesus walk by, John the Baptist said, "Behold, the Lamb of God."
- 13. John 20: 8 When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. (I will explain this story a message from Jesus)
- 14. Mark 1: 31 Simon's mother-in-law lay sick with a fever. They immediately told him about her. He approached, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Then the fever left her

- 15. John 1: 48 Nathaniel " How do you know me?" Jesus said " Before Phillip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you. '
- 16. Matthew 4: 1Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. Jesus answers three times from Scripture e.g. Man does not live by bread alone.....
- 17. John 1: 33 John Baptist I did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'On whomever you see the Spirit come down and remain, he is the one who will baptize with the holy Spirit.'
- 18. Mark 5: 25 There was a woman afflicted with haemorrhages for twelve years. v 28 She said, "If I but touch his clothes, I shall be cured." v 30 Jesus asked, "Who has touched my clothes?"
- 19. Jesus said v 34 "Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction."
- 20. Disregarding the message that was reported, Jesus said to the synagogue official, v 36 "Do not be afraid; just have faith." Which gift? Yes but who had the gift this time?
- 21.v 41 Jesus said "Talitha koum," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately
- 22. John 8:4 "Teacher, this woman was caught in the very act of committing adultery". Jesus said " "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."
- 23. Mathew 16: 18 and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.
- 24.John 1: 35 and as he watched Jesus walk by, John the Baptist said, "Behold, the Lamb of God."
- 25. Acts 3: 6 Peter said, "I have neither silver nor gold, but what I do have I give you: in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazorean, (rise and) walk." Two gifts which ones?
- 26. John 13: 38 Jesus answered, "Will you lay down your life for me? Amen, amen, I say to you, the cock will not crow before you deny me three times."
- 27. Matthew 14: 16 "There is no need for them to go away; give them some food yourselves v 21 Those who ate were about five thousand men, not counting women and children. **There are two gifts.**
- 28. Luke 6: 12 In those days he departed to the mountain to pray, and he spent the night in prayer to God. When day came, he called his disciples to himself, and from them he chose Twelve, whom he also named apostles.
- 29. Luke 19: 5When he reached the place, Jesus looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." (Fr Nicholas adds How does he know t hename?)
