

## PROPHETIC SHARING 27 NOVEMBER 2021

### PROPHETIC WORDS GIVEN AT ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL

*Prophecy isn't primarily about telling the future. It's essentially giving us current insight into God's plan and His Word, calling us back to what's already been revealed in public revelation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that although "Revelation is complete, it has not been made completely explicit; it remains for Christian faith gradually to grasp its full significance". (CCC66) Prophecy encourages us and reminds us of the heart of Christianity: of God's love, His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus and His presence with us through the power of the Holy Spirit.*

*The following words were given at Alton Day of Renewal, and we believe they are from the Lord. We hope you find them inspiring, encouraging, or comforting. Although we have prayed and discerned that they are in line with the teaching of the Church, please bear in mind that "Private revelations... do not belong to the deposit of faith. It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history." (CCC67)*

### ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL WORDS OF PROPHECY 27/11/21

#### First Word

"I want to say this: It is no mean thing you do to come before Me in prayer and sacrifice. All will be accomplished that you beg Me for, in this time and in this place. I am here, truly present to you in My very self. Don't ignore Me, take Me home with yourself to be Me where you are. I shelter you from all dangers, I guide you along the path I have set before you and I lift you up and make you strong to fulfil all I ask of you. Be blessed today and always."

#### Second Word

During Adoration – it was probably a reminder for me but it may affect other people – I was looking at the candles and the beam of light, then I closed my eyes in prayer and one of the beams in my thinking changed into a sword just for a fragment of time and then the words: "You won't know joy until you know sorrow." That was very much a reminder of an event that took place many years ago out of the blue. For some reason I was reminded of it again, so I hope it helps anyone.

#### Third Word

I had a picture of many little boats sheltering in a harbour. They were all lit up against a thick fog that was rolling in. Then the Lord said:

"My dear children, I am calling you now into a deeper level of trust in me. I am your protector, your safe harbour from the difficulties of this world. When troubles and uncertainties come, I will be the shield surrounding you for I am your strength & your defender. Come my dear ones, do not hold back! Strengthen the chains on your anchors today through your prayers, repentance, adoration and praise and let me enfold you in the harbour of my heart where you will have peace and nothing to fear."

*The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run into it and are safe. Proverbs 18:10*

#### Fourth Word

This is for a lady who is here – I think it's probably a mother – and I sense the Lord saying: "Do not lose hope for I have heard your prayers as I know what lays heavy on your heart. Even now things are changing, and you will witness resolution very shortly." I prayed to the Lord about that, and I think it's very specific. It's a family issue that began in September this year.

**Fifth Word**

Yesterday I got the word “Restoration” and this morning I asked the Lord if he wanted to give me an encouraging word for today and this is what I sensed the Lord saying: “My beloved, know that I am with you all. None are separated or alone, but I bring you together as my body, joined together as one in me. No-one is separated for my love covers all, is in all and flows through all. Turn to me in all things, at all times and in every event and relationship, for I am with you. All will be restored. All will be restored. Have courage and hope in me. All that seems impossible at this time will be made possible by me. There is nothing or nobody that can separate you from the love I have for you. Move forward in my love, my courage, my hope and my peace. I am with you always. I am with you.”

And a Scripture I read this morning was Daniel 3:82 “Bless the Lord all you people on earth, sing praise to Him and exalt Him above all forever.” And the ALL was very important. And in Adoration the words that came to me were: “The light of Christ overcomes all darkness.” And I have a sense that the Lord wants whoever this speaks to, to receive more of the Holy Spirit, to let this word resonate in your heart; to receive more of the Holy Spirit as we come into Advent.

**Sixth Word**

I just wanted to say when the Blessed Sacrament was shown it was so beautiful – the light and the gold and everything – and the rays that were coming from the Sacred Heart of Jesus: we were in union.

**Seventh word**

During Adoration I had Revelation 21:5 “Behold I am making all things new. What I tell you is trustworthy and true.” And “Remember, I stand at the door and knock” (Revelation 3:20) “But you must open that door and let me into your heart and your life. And then my spirit can overshadow you, and you will then bear fruit that will endure.”

**Eighth word**

I wanted to confirm what was said in the third word. I also had the idea that God is the shield protecting the people who trust Him and belong to Him.

**Ninth Word**

During the Adoration I got a picture that there’s somebody on this forum who is a bit frightened to show themselves or speak out what they are getting. But what they have is important for other people in the meeting. This is a safe environment, and they need to speak out what they’ve actually got on their heart.

**Tenth word**

I was praying on Monday evening about whether or not I should be writing a poem (I write many poems led by the Holy Spirit). So I prayed to the Holy Spirit about this and got a tingling at the top of my head which is a sign I seem to get when the Holy Spirit is active. I started to write and really didn’t know how it was going to come out. I’ve called it “Winter Berries”.

Red winter berries are on the tree. See their perfect roundness,  
Their glistening skins, their green stalks and delicate leaves.  
The tree is blossoming with life, its vibrant colours catch our eyes,  
And their beauty our awe-filled hearts. The winter berries are small,  
But for free-flying birds taste so wonderful, a precious fruit, a heavenly gift.  
They hold on tight, for their time to fall is not yet here,  
But fall they will, at the Master’s touch.  
Frost adorns the red; ice makes the green leaf veins protrude,  
Creating a stunning pattern. How they become an even greater work of art!  
The craftsman looks on and the time is near.

Do not fear, for the loving creator is calling you.  
Just be prepared, patient, expectant and aware.

### **Eleventh word**

What I got was “Relax, rest and restore”. I just texted it to a work colleague who is under pressure but it could also be for any of us.

### **Twelfth word**

During Adoration I was noticing how the Blessed Sacrament was being exposed in Fr Paul’s sitting room and it just struck me how lovely it was that the Lord’s presence was there in such ordinary surroundings. It seemed to me that this was very significant: Jesus the King and Lord of the Universe wants to be with us in the ordinary surroundings of our lives. I was particularly struck also by the way that Fr Paul said he prayed “Come Holy Spirit” before he did ordinary things like answering the phone. Then these words came to me:

“Invite me into every part of your life; open every door to me. Do not exclude me from anything that you do. Ask for my help in your everyday activities. I am always ready and willing to help. I do not judge you for I only want to love you and help you to grow into my likeness.”

I was really struck by how many other words given today contain elements of what I just said – it’s lovely how the Holy Spirit brings it all together.

### **Thirteenth word**

My people, I am calling you to redouble your efforts in prayer. Make this season joyful, expectant and prayerful. Put Me at the heart of each day - at the beginning, in the middle and at the end. Make each moment one of praise and communication with Me. Turn to Me in all your needs. Share with Me all your joys and all your sorrows.

### **Fourteenth word**

I get periods racked with doubt and when I do, I get the words “I am with you; trust me, I am always with you.” I find that very consoling. It’s the word TRUST that comes out most strongly. We trust in the Lord.

### **Fifteenth word**

I just wanted to confirm what was shared in the poem earlier. I’ve been doing walks in the woods and I’m just amazed by the beauty of the holly so heavy laden with berries. The last part of the poem really touched my heart – it’s almost talking to me directly and I praise and thank God for that. Thank you, Jesus. Amen.

### **Sixteenth word**

During adoration I had a picture of the good shepherd and the words “The Lord is my shepherd, do not be afraid.”

### **Seventeenth word**

“DO NOT BE AFRAID, for I have redeemed you. I have called you by your name. You are mine.”

### **Eighteenth word**

“There is a time for every season. This is the time for healing. This is the time for new beginnings. This is the time to work for me, be my hands and feet. Trust in God’s love, infinite, always present and there for you, wonderful, beautiful, all embracing. Trust in the Lord.”

### **Nineteenth word**

When Andrew was praying over us (at the end of his talk) I had a picture of a pile of logs in an apron being poured onto the fire. I felt that this was twofold: the graces being poured down on us to build us up and the prayers we are called to say to fan the flames of God’s love in us to take out to others.
