PROPHETIC WORDS GIVEN AT ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL

Prophecy isn't primarily about telling the future. It's essentially giving us current insight into God's plan and His Word, calling us back to what's already been revealed in public revelation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that although "Revelation is complete, it has not been made completely explicit; it remains for Christian faith gradually to grasp its full significance". (CCC66) Prophecy encourages us and reminds us of the heart of Christianity: of God's love, His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus and His presence with us through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The following words were given at Alton Day of Renewal, and we believe they are from the Lord. But they will not all be relevant f]or everyone: you need to pray to the Holy Spirit for discernment about whether God is speaking to you personally about something. We hope you find them inspiring, encouraging, or comforting. Although we have prayed and discerned that they are in line with Scripture and the teaching of the Church, please bear in mind that "Private revelations.... do not belong to the deposit of faith. It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history." (CCC67)

ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL WORDS OF PROPHECY 25/11/2023

First word

During the adoration I had a picture of me standing just at the edge of a river. I think I had just my toes in the river. And I should mention that we've had some really amazing answers to prayers recently, just quite, quite amazing. And then as I was praying, I think the Lord was inviting me to come deeper into the water. He was saying you're just standing at the edge now just walk deeper into my stream of living water and you'll see things that you can't even imagine. You'll have prayers answered that will really surprise you. So praise the Lord!

Second word

I'm only saying this because the Lord said, tell them because it's more like a testimony. Well, it's a long story, but I'm going to cut it short. It's prompted by one of the readings. "Do not be afraid of the ones who kill the body." It happened at New Dawn and the whole week that year I had the word: "Jesus wept" and I said "Why? Because of my sins? And then He said "heart of a child." And then when we went back to the Prayer meeting in Oxford, what I shared with my brothers and sisters was one of the words this morning "Do not be afraid of the ones who kill the body." So we were prompted to pray for the women that abort children. So three of us, Michael myself another one, we went around the abortion clinic in Oxford singing: "Send your power, send your power." And we heard later, after a week, that the Thursday clinic had be shut down because they couldn't find a surgeon who killed children.

Third word

Just before the Mass started, I was completely blank and I thought, oh, do you want to say something? I opened my Bible at Romans 10 and it was just so appropriate, about proclaiming the good news, at the end of this year that was all about proclaiming the good news. Then the Lord gave me these words to say:

"My dear Ones, how beautiful are the feet of you who bring the Good News of my love to those living in darkness and despair, without hope. My children, know that the Word is near you; it is in your mouths and in your hearts. It is the Word of Faith that you proclaim, so that they may believe in my love, call on me in their distress, and be comforted. Blessed are you who confess with your

mouth that Jesus is Lord. and believe in your heart that he was risen from the dead, for the Kingdom of heaven is yours. I am with you always."

Fourth word

Revelation 4: 11 says "Thou art worthy O Lord to receive glory and honour and power. For thou hast created all things and for thy pleasure they are and were created." Now this scripture, where the 24 elders constantly worship before the throne, I think is God's purpose for us here on earth. Like heaven here on earth is the same purpose which he wanted to show Adam, when he first sinned, that I want to bring heaven on earth. And each of us, as born again Christians, when we pray in Matthew 6: 10, thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven, we are called to be in constant praise to our God and this gives him pleasure. That's the reason why he's created each of us. Because, when you see the relationship between a father and a son, the father gets extreme pleasure when the son appreciates the small things he has done in his life.

And I think that God our father is waiting for that appreciation: although it doesn't increase his power and glory, by giving him praise and thanks, but it gives us a different insight of who we are. We are very powerful beings on earth where God has given his glory to be shared. And I think the whole thing about pleasure, you know, just highlights to me that God isn't absolutely off in making us as individuals and giving us gifts on this earth; and in return we have to give him pleasure by glorifying and praising him.

Fifth word

I wasn't going to say anything but when someone just said that Jesus wept, I was having a conversation when we were praying for the people of the Holy Land and this terrible war that's going on and someone said well what's God doing about it and I said well, what did Jesus do when he looked at Jerusalem? He wept. So I said Jesus is weeping over the Holy Land. That was all I wanted to share. Jesus wept and he's weeping now and all we can do is pray. Thank you.

Sixth word

I just wanted to say that when I was looking at the sacrament at the adoration. I thought it was very nice the way the candles were around it, or the lights. And it brought to my mind something in my past. I probably bury it a little bit and I thought well, the Lord needs to heal that. And I just felt that the Lord was saying to us, there are things deep in our past that we need to allow him to heal so that we can move forward in the power of the Spirit.

Seventh word

I've got a word of knowledge, I believe. During the Mass Father Anthony had a reading about springs of living water flowing. And that very much resonated with me, and I could see the rain coming down. And then the rain became like a torrent of gushing waters flowing, wherever it went. And with it, I had the number 88. So I ask the Lord what it means and He said that 8 is the number of completeness. A number of blessings. So I believe that the outpouring of the Holy Spirit is coming upon England, upon us or maybe even a personal outpouring. And that it should be complete. The rain will become small, but then it will become a torrent of living water.

And I've got the verse John. 4:13 about the Samaritan woman. Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again. But whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst, for the water that I shall give him will become for him a fountain of water springing up to eternal life. Alleluia!

Eighth word

I had towards the end of adoration the image of a sunflower that seemed to bigger and bigger and bigger and then it exploded and all the seeds got scattered and just burst out from the centre. And all the petals were just drifting away in the wind and it makes me realize that nothing is going to be able to stop God's Word going to every place it wants to go, whether it is in the past or in the future or present. It will go where he wants it to go and that it will be carried. And that whatever seeds he wants to plant will be planted. It was just the enormity of it as I could see it sort of explode.

Ninth word

I'm going to give the word that I received during Adoration, which confirms quite a few of what have been said already: about immersing ourselves deeper into the river of life and also about not being afraid. And I believe this is what Lord said: "Do not be afraid to immerse yourself more deeply in my holiness. Do not be afraid to speak in the language that my spirit gives you, as you surrender your will and your voice to me. Do not be afraid to speak to others of your love for me, and your joy in all that I do for you." And it's just amazing that the Lord gave me those during adoration and so many of the other words that have been given already reflect aspects of that.

Tenth word

"Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' but fail to do what I tell you? I will show you what everyone is like who comes to me and hears my words and acts in accordance with them. He is like a man who in building a house dug deeply and laid its foundations on rock. When the flood rose, it burst against that house but could not shake it because it had been solidly constructed." (Luke 7:46-48)

Eleventh word

The Lord is making us new. He is recreating us. He is giving us new blood (His own blood), new cells, new tissue. He is healing us. Alleluia.

Twelfth word

I confirm the word earlier that God is healing us from issues in our past physically, emotionally, spiritually, etc.

Thirteenth word

I can also confirm it: God is the greatest healer for past, present and the future. Amen!

Fourteenth word

I got in Adoration that our hearts are gushed full of Blood of Jesus to heal all of our hardness and pain and then saw from top of head to bottom of feet were dipped in the Blood of Jesus!

Fifteenth word

John 4:13 "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst again. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life".

Sixteenth word

Colossians 3:14-15 "Clothe yourselves with tender hearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Make allowance for each other's faults and forgive others. Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony."

Seventeenth word

With God, nothing is lost; but without Him, everything is lost.

Eighteenth word

One of the candles wasn't burning as brightly as the others Was the Lord asking us "How brightly does your light shine?"

WORDS OF KNOWLEDGE FOR HEALING

Cold hands – Raynaud's Disease Backache

Painful mouth – Ulcers Bunged-up nose Someone suffering from anxiety and fear Cramp at night

Nightmares Anxiety

Sudden violent stomach ache – see a doctor Night sweats

FOLLOW-UP TO PROPHETIC WORDS

These comments came in a day or two later.

First follow up

I was in attendance on Saturday. It was wonderful being in the presence of God. Two things that I would like to point out:

- 1. The session on adoration and the subsequent prophetic messages were profound. I was touched not only by the words of knowledge, but also by the confirmations of the Words of Knowledge. In particular, the message that God was healing things in our past including physically, emotionally, and spiritually. This was confirmed by me and two others.
- 2. That night (Saturday night) I dreamed a physical recreation of the ADORE fellowship or prayer meeting. The word I got after this dream was that all of us who attended were living in the prophetic grace of the ADORE fellowship. So I would like to convey my thanks to you for organizing the event.

Second follow-up

This revelation [the seventh word] is very personal to me:

- 1. About the river, which has been my prayer point for a long, long time. I didn't realise or somehow missed it that the prayer meeting was the same theme (I signed up the day before and it was my first full day at ADORE) and I wept, overwhelmed by God's love during the meeting at the multiple confirmations.
- 2. The number 888. I saw exactly this number very clearly in a dream about two weeks ago and I've been pondering the meaning ever since as I knew it was a message from the Lord.
