PROPHETIC WORDS GIVEN AT ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL

Prophecy isn't primarily about telling the future. It's essentially giving us current insight into God's plan and His Word, calling us back to what's already been revealed in public revelation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that although "Revelation is complete, it has not been made completely explicit; it remains for Christian faith gradually to grasp its full significance". (CCC66) Prophecy encourages us and reminds us of the heart of Christianity: of God's love, His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus and His presence with us through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The following words were given at Alton Day of Renewal, and we believe they are from the Lord. But they will not all be relevant for everyone: you need to pray to the Holy Spirit for discernment about whether God is speaking to you personally about something. We hope you find them inspiring, encouraging, or comforting. Although we have prayed and discerned that they are in line with Scripture and the teaching of the Church, please bear in mind that "Private revelations.... do not belong to the deposit of faith. It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history." (CCC67)

ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL WORDS OF PROPHECY 27/7/2024

First Word

"Look at the book of my word. Read it avidly. Devour every page. Learn the Gospels off by heart. Be always ready to share my word with others. What would Jesus do is there in front of you. Come back to right living, to moral judgment, to love, and peace and joy; and come back to Faith."

And then I thought, Okay, you really want me to look at the Bible. So I opened the Bible I have by my computer and this is what I got. Psalm 37: "Do not get heated about the wicked, or envy those who do wrong. Quick as the grass they wither, fading like the green of the fields. Put your trust in Yahweh and do right. Make your home in the land and live secure. Make Yahweh your joy, and he will give you your heart's desires. Commit your destiny to Yahweh. Be confident in him, and he will act, making your uprightness clear as daylight and the justice of your cause as the noon."

Second word

I had these words: "Oh, how I long for our lives to mingle; I long for you to share my life. United with me, stagnant waters may be made fresh; barren land can be made fertile; hard hearts can be made soft. Do you truly believe that I can make integrity and praise spring up in the sight of the nations?"

Third word

"It is with great joy that I look on you today, just as you look on Me. 'Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid' as I told you. Worry and fear should have no part in your lives. Trust yourselves wholly to Me and all will be well. This I promise you."

Fourth word

I had picture of an angelic trumpet that was being played. This is when the Blessed Sacrament was exposed. And as it was playing it was shooting out heavenly pollen and seeds. It was shooting it out to others, to activate them on their journey. So I pray this word: Lord, I thank you that the word says about the angels with the trumpets, and I thank you, Lord, that through the Blessed Sacrament being exposed, Lord, that trumpet was shooting out heavenly seeds and pollen, and I pray, Lord, that we would all catch it, so that we will be activated and in turn we can activate others. Amen.

Fifth word

"My children, it grieves me when I see your worries for your lives and your children. How can I make you trust me? I see all the pieces, and how they fit together. I can bring good out of situations in ways you cannot see. Never fear, know that I am with you always. Do not be dismayed, let me lead you and navigate the path ahead. For I will strengthen you and uphold you with my righteous right hand." That was Isaiah 41:10. And then the key verse is from Proverbs 3:5-6. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways submit to him and he will make your path straight."

Sixth word

During adoration I had a strong sense that Jesus was saying: "Behold, I'm making all things new. That word is from Isaiah 43:19. But I then had a sense that, while Jesus was doing his part, There's a condition for us, there's an expectation that we are doing ours. Asking him "What is it that you're expecting us to do?" And then, Ephesians 4:23-24 came through, and it's this verse: "Be renewed in the spirit of your minds. And put on the new self, created after the likeness of God, in true righteousness and holiness." It took me back to the theme of holiness and being renewed in our mind. Jesus is doing his bit, but we have to do ours too.

Seventh word

The calling which was mentioned earlier today and our election. is that we're given divine power for everything needed in life, and godliness. If we go to 2 Peter chapter one verse 5, it says that "for this reason you must make every effort to support your faith with goodness; and goodness with knowledge; and knowledge with self control; and self control with endurance; and endurance with godliness; and godliness with mutual affection; and mutual affection with love.

And if we have these things and they increase amongst us, we will be very effective and very fruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ." I hope that's helpful.

Eighth word

At the start of adoration, I saw these hands extended from the base of the monstrance, and I heard the words, "Surrender! Surrender yourself, surrender yourself to me."

Ninth word

What came to me this morning before the meeting was the line from Psalm 118: "This is the day the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad in it." And during adoration I asked for a further word to extend that and I felt the Lord saying: "I want you to give your full attention to me. Be present to me, as I am always present to you. Don't be distracted by mistakes of the past or worries for the future. Be present to me now. Be aware of my everlasting love and mercy. Rejoice, and be glad that I am sustaining your life and live your life to the full, filled with my Spirit."

Tenth word

A simple life lived well is a peaceful life.

Eleventh word

The humble person will be rewarded manifold.

Twelfth Word

Isaiah14:7 – "All the forces of darkness cannot stop what God has ordained."

Thirteenth Word

Jude v20-23: "But, dearly beloved, build your life on the foundation of your most holy faith praying in the Holy Spirit. Remain firm in the love of Jesus Christ our Lord which leads to eternal life. Try to convince those who doubt; others you will save, snatching them from condemnation. Treat the others with compassion, but also with prudence, shunning even the clothes that touch their body."

Fourteenth Word

I felt the Lord was saying 'Do not be afraid'

Fifteenth Word

The Lord of Hosts is raising an Army. Joshua 1:9 – "Behold, I am instructing you. Be strengthened and be steadfast. Do not dread, and do not fear. For the Lord your God is with you in all things, wherever you may go."

Sixteenth Word

"You are the light shining in the darkness. Cleave the darkness with the sword of My Spirit. Fight back against what holds you back. Move forward."
