PROPHETIC WORDS GIVEN AT ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL

Prophecy isn't primarily about telling the future. It's essentially giving us current insight into God's plan and His Word, calling us back to what's already been revealed in public revelation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that although "Revelation is complete, it has not been made completely explicit; it remains for Christian faith gradually to grasp its full significance". (CCC66) Prophecy encourages us and reminds us of the heart of Christianity: of God's love, His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus and His presence with us through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The following words were given at Alton Day of Renewal, and we believe they are from the Lord. But they will not all be relevant for everyone: you need to pray to the Holy Spirit for discernment about whether God is speaking to you personally about something. We hope you find them inspiring, encouraging, or comforting. Although we have prayed and discerned that they are in line with Scripture and the teaching of the Church, please bear in mind that "Private revelations.... do not belong to the deposit of faith. It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history." (CCC67)

ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL WORDS OF PROPHECY 23/11/2024

First Word

"I come before you in mercy and sacrificially. Temper your emotions with gladness at My presence among you this day, for I mean to pour out on you a fervent trust in Me for all your doings, prayers and needs"

Second Word

When I was contemplating, the word "full" has been a word that's been ongoing and it came back again this morning - just that word full. But I felt that God said, "I'm the God of eternity. I live outside of time and space." And again, "I've counted every hair on your head and of all my children. I hear all your prayers. Not one have I missed. Leave all with me. Surrender all to me. I will take care of it all. My ways are not your ways. My thoughts are not your thoughts. Seek not your own understanding." And then there was Matthew 7 came up, and also "Abide in me and I will abide in you." And also that scripture, "faith as small as a mustard seed can move mountains."

Third word

I think when you read 1 Chronicle 16 about worshipping the Lord in His holy splendour, I felt the Lord was saying to us: "I want you to share the burden of my heart with me. The cry of my people for peace. This is a time of quickening as you enter a golden anniversary and travel as pilgrims of hope. Behold, I am doing a new thing and all will see the salvation of God." And I had a sense that God was reminding us. He was reconnecting the Old and the New Testaments so that "behold, I'm doing a new thing" from Isaiah and then Luke "all will see the salvation of God."

And then I was taken back to what was shared by our priest this morning in Mass. It was a reminder basically that we are sinners, but we are sinners who are loved by God. Jesus has given us his peace. We are living in troubling times, but a reminder that that peace surpasses all understanding. And the sense that one time period is closing but a new one is beginning and we are to travel as pilgrims of hope, knowing that the peace of Jesus is with us.

Fourth word

The Lord gave me a message for everybody, it's 1Samuel 8:7 ("the Lord told him: Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king.") Because, you know, when we witness, we're often rejected, and it's this encouragement: they have not rejected you, they have rejected me as their king. So not to take it personally. I think that's the message for all of us.

Fifth word

This comes from this morning, in fact. I felt the Lord was saying: "even more than my thoughts being higher than your thoughts, my timing is higher and it's not your timing. Do not expect to know times and seasons. Even my son Jesus did not know when the times of tribulations would come."

Sixth word

I've been very distracted this morning with some technical problems, then eventually just towards the end of the adoration time, I thought, I've got to concentrate - what is the Lord saying to me? And he seemed to be saying: "Don't be anxious about distractions. use them as a prompt to prayer. I can work through the deepest darkness to bring you my light. Then, when you see even the smallest light from me, Focus on that and I will grow greater to overcome all the darkness." So I found that very encouraging and I hope other people do as well.

Seventh word

"Be righteous, even when the righteous are not popular."

Eighth word

"I am King of the Universe and you know that I am your King, My good and faithful servants. Trust in Me and My plan for you always. The road is hard but I am always with you."

Ninth word

I was looking at the monstrance and thought of a ship's wheel and "I am guiding you." I turned to my little prayer book and that was the opening sentence.

Tenth word

Romans 10 14-15 "But how can they call upon the name of the Lord without having believed in him? And how can they believe in him without first hearing about him? And how will they hear about him if no one preaches about him? And how will they preach about him if no one sends them? As scripture says, How beautiful are the feet of the messenger of Good News."

Eleventh word

"It is not about the army, it is about my Spirit".

Twelfth Word

"The joy of the Lord is my strength." (Psalm 118)

Thirteenth word

“The times of trial are sent to make us - not BREAK us.”

Fourteenth word

“Do not worry about all that is going on around you but trust in me.”

Fifteenth word

I had exactly the same command "you must not worry". It was a command, not a polite request; we must not worry, as witnesses.
