PROPHETIC WORDS GIVEN AT ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL

Prophecy isn't primarily about telling the future. It's essentially giving us current insight into God's plan and His Word, calling us back to what's already been revealed in public revelation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states that although "Revelation is complete, it has not been made completely explicit; it remains for Christian faith gradually to grasp its full significance". (CCC66) Prophecy encourages us and reminds us of the heart of Christianity: of God's love, His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus and His presence with us through the power of the Holy Spirit.

The following words were given at Alton Day of Renewal, and we believe they are from the Lord. But they will not all be relevant for everyone: you need to pray to the Holy Spirit for discernment about whether God is speaking to you personally about something. We hope you find them inspiring, encouraging, or comforting. Although we have prayed and discerned that they are in line with Scripture and the teaching of the Church, please bear in mind that "Private revelations.... do not belong to the deposit of faith. It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history." (CCC67)

****We have discerned that the Words below marked with an asterisk are not strictly speaking prophecies, but are interesting observations.***

ALTON DAY OF RENEWAL WORDS OF PROPHECY 26/7/2025

First Word

This I have to say - honour My power and might in the blessed Eucharist, for I am here present in all my majesty, though hidden from your eyes. Know the truth of it and let it unsettle you to seek My presence here, in it, regularly. It will do you much good.

Second Word

I sense the Lord saying: "I long for you to raise your eyes above all that is seeming to crowd in on you, and look beyond the clutter and confusion. Look to the horizon, to where I am calling you. Now is the time to step out in faith, even though the way ahead is not a clear path and the future seems uncertain. What is certain is that I am with you, and I will show you the way. As you open your heart to me, I will guide your feet. I am the way, the truth, and the life". I then sensed God saying, "Faith is not stagnant, it's a movement, a catalyst that propels us into the fullness of God's purposes for us."

Third Word

There was a sense of a sort of division, of a line in the Blessed Sacrament down the middle, and the words I got were, "Martha, you are distracted by so many things, only one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the better part. There is no condemnation for those who are in me and with me. There is only one way, one narrow, straight path. Many are called, but few are chosen. I have chosen you to bear fruit, fruit that will last. Do not be afraid. Abide in me, and I will abide in you. My word is the signpost to the destination I am calling you to. I want my heartbeat to beat in unison with my children in the world."

Fourth Word

The Lord's been talking to me this week about the atmosphere of heaven... Where everything is heard, and every action is filtered through the lens of his love. And there's a verse of Scripture, Ecclesiastes 3.11 which tells us that God has made everything beautiful in His time, but has also set eternity within the human heart. So this means that we are children of the King of Heaven, we all carry heaven within our hearts. He showed me that there's a heavy and dark atmosphere growing in our world today. And I saw that many people walking with their heads bowed, struggling with difficulties of all times, loneliness and despair. And then I saw that as he stretched out his hand and touched them, they all raised their heads and their faces lit up.

And then he said, "My children. I'm calling you to bring a glimpse of heaven to everyone you meet, in every situation. I want you to walk in the atmosphere of heaven. For in these days it's my love that will triumph. Would you agree to ask me every day for opportunities to bring a little piece of heaven into the lives of those around you. When you do so, I will dress you in a garment of radiant love, so bright that Joy will touch our hearts." And then I saw that even a smile, a friendly wave, or a simple compliment lit people up as you touch them. It is his love that will triumph over this present darkness.

Fifth Word

Before the meeting started, I asked the Lord to give me a Bible reference, and he took me to John 14:26 which is, "The counsellor, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name will teach you all things. And will remind you of everything I have said to you." And then, during the adoration time, I asked the Lord what He wanted to say through this. And he said, "I have given you my Spirit to teach and remind you of everything I said, but... Are you asking him to teach you? Are you listening to him? And are you doing what I said? My spirit will not force you, you have to be willing to be taught and docile to my will."

Sixth Word*

The reflection in the glass of the monstrance said to me that adoration is a window into the heart of Father God.

Seventh Word

I felt God saying: "I just want you to be still in my presence and I will speak to your heart."

Eighth Word

"Come to me all who labour and are heavy burdened and I will give you rest."

Ninth Word*

The Blessed Sacrament appeared like a Precious Pearl. The priceless Pearl as in the Bible, the treasure in the field.

Tenth Word

Eleventh Word*
