



ALL LIFE IS VALUABLE, NFP

As a foster family for All Life Is Valuable, NFP I/We agree to the following:

1. All foster pets are and will remain property of All Life IS Valuable, NFP (here after known as ALIV), even while in the care of the foster family. The foster family is expected to provide daily care of the foster pet until they are adopted. In no way, has taking physical possession of or providing care for the foster pet allowed for the transfer of ownership of the foster pet. Ownership of any foster pet will only be transferred by the completion of an Adoption Contract. ALIV reserves the right to reclaim physical possession of the foster pet at any time, for any reason, without any notice, and with the help of local authorities. **Initial** _____
2. Neither the foster family, immediate family, or anyone else that the foster pet may reside or have frequent contact with, has ever been charged with neglect of, or cruelty to animals in any fashion. **Initial** _____
3. ALIV provides necessary veterinary care for their foster pets. All veterinary treatment for foster pets **MUST** be preauthorized by ALIV Board Member at an ALIV affiliated veterinarian. **Initial** _____
4. The foster pet shall be kept as an indoor house pet. Outside areas are intended for exercise only, and under no circumstances will be deemed an appropriate living area for any ALIV foster pet. When foster dog is out walking, the animal will always be leashed and never allowed to walk off leash for any reason. Furthermore, the foster pet will not be permanently tethered to any fixed object for more than 30 minutes at a time. The foster family shall provide daily exercise for the foster pet by way of enclosed area, leash walking, regular play, social interaction, or other physical activity. No ALIV foster dog shall ever be allowed to go to a dog park. Any and all expenses related to this task, will be the responsibility of the foster family. **Initial** _____
5. While ALIV will provide supplies, the foster family shall offer sufficient food of a good quality, water, shelter, proper grooming, administer flea and tick prevention and comply with any medically necessary veterinary care, including but not limited to; routine vaccinations, annual fecal exams, annual heartworm testing and prevention, for as long as the foster pet is in the care of the foster family. **Initial** _____
6. The foster pet will not be neglected, abused, or mistreated in anyway. The foster pet will not be given, leased or sold to a laboratory or other facility, and will not be the subject of any experimentation. The foster pet will not be used in any form of animal fighting, racing, or any other revenue generating activity. **Initial** _____



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7. The foster family acknowledges that although the foster pet has received medical attention as well as temperament testing, ALIV cannot guarantee the temperament or behavior of the foster pet. **Initial** _____
8. ALIV requires all resident pets to be up to date with all vaccines at least 2 weeks prior to receiving a new foster pet. This is to ensure the health and wellness of the resident pets. ALIV is not responsible for sickness or any other health concerns related to the resident pets of the foster family.

9. Occasionally, foster pets will have conditions that will require follow up and additional visits to an affiliated veterinarian. The foster family agrees to transport their foster pet to and from the veterinarian if required by ALIV in case of sickness or other health reasons. ALIV will make every attempt to use the closest affiliated veterinarian for the convenience of the foster family.

10. ALIV will occasionally hold adoption events. Attending these events with your foster pet gives them more exposure and a better chance of being adopted. It is the foster family's responsibility to bring the foster pet to the event OR to make arrangements with an ALIV board member to ensure their foster pet's attendance. ALIV will communicate dates, times and locations of adoption events 4 weeks prior to event to allow for scheduling. Further, each foster family is required to provide at least 1 update and photo of the foster pet per week for social medial promotional purposes.

11. In the event the foster family has provided any false information on their initial application to ALIV and/or any of the terms of this agreement have not been fulfilled, ALIV reserves the right to immediately take physical possession of the foster pet from any party, any location, by any necessary means, up to and including legal action. The above named foster family will also be responsible for any and all legal fees incurred by ALIV in an effort to enforce this contract.
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12. If you are no longer able to fulfill your obligations as a foster family, or the foster pet should need to be returned to ALIV for any reason, it is the responsibility of the foster family to provide transportation back ALIV or authorized Board Member. **Initial** _____



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13. The foster family agrees to always provide current and accurate contact information to ALIV including but not limited to; home address, home phone number, cell phone number, email address, etc. for in the event that the fosterpet becomes lost or stolen. Foster family also agrees to exhaust all options in locating the foster pet by filing lost reports with their local police department, animal control, animal shelter, veterinary clinics, etc. as well as placing ads in the local newspaper, locally posting flyers, listings online, etc. **Initial**

14. Foster(s) agrees to indemnify and hold harmless ALIV, directors, representatives, associated veterinarians, groomers, trainers, or other affiliated service providers, and volunteers including other fosters, from any direct or consequential damages arising from this Animal Foster Parent Application or even the act of fostering itself. This includes any and all manner of actions and causes of actions, suits, debts, dues, accounts, bonds, covenants, agreements, judgments, claims, and demands whatsoever arising from or relating to the fostering, adoption, placement, and/or possession of the foster pet and party also agrees to waive any and all rights of subrogation for any and all claims made against ALIV.
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
