What is it?

The main aim of targeted youth work is to support young people early who are experiencing difficulties.



Targeted Youth Work in partnership with other agencies will support young people and help them on the path to success.

Targeted Youth Work is aimed at Young People between the ages of 11 & 19 (up to age 25 for young people with disabilities) who are experiencing difficulties or taking risks and require help and support to prevent their difficulties escalating.

Bespoke programmes are tailored to meet Young People's needs and are designed to be delivered in a group setting. However if a young person has a need for further intervention there can be some 1:1 support (mentoring/advocacy) if appropriate.
