Grass cuttings
Leaves
Weeds
Flowers and plants

Paper
Animal bedding or litter
Nappies

Stone and Rubble
Large Branches
Plastic bags
Any other household waste

What happens to the contents of the green bin?

They are placed in open windrows to compost and is then used by farmers as a soil improver.

Why should I recycle?

The more we recycle the less waste has to be sent to landfill which is increasingly expensive and produces greenhouse emissions which are harmful to the environment.
