You should not be putting the following materials in the grey bin:

Paper and magazines Glass bottles and jars
Tin and aluminium food and drink cans
Plastic bottles Garden Waste Cardboard

How to use your grey waste bin?

Any waste placed in your grey bin will be taken to landfill.

The cost of disposing of waste to landfill is increasing every year and this will impact on Council Tax bills in the future.

You can reduce this cost by recycling as much as possible and minimising the amount of waste put into the grey bin.

The council are able to sell all recycling materials placed in the recycling bins and this helps to minimise the costs of waste disposal which, in turn, minimises the impact on your council tax bill.

If there are 5 or more permanent residents at your address you may be eligible for an additional capacity waste bin. You can obtain an application form by contacting the waste management helpline on 01226 772045 or visit our website at Barnsley.gov.uk/waste.
