



Armuchee Ruritan Justin W. Johnson Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship honors the memory of Justin, a 2000 graduate of Armuchee High School, who was killed on April 10, 2004 in Baghdad, Iraq. Justin was assigned to the United States Army's 1st Battalion, 82nd Field Artillery Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division, serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Originally created in 2005 by the Armuchee-Glenwood Education Foundation, the scholarship was taken over by the Armuchee Ruritan Club in 2015 and is awarded annually to a graduating senior of Armuchee High School to pursue an undergraduate education at the college or university of their choice. First preference is given to students who have had a member of their immediate family killed or seriously injured while serving in the United States Armed Forces or as a volunteer or paid member of a Public Safety agency. If there are no students who qualify based on the above circumstances, the Scholarship Committee will use criteria based on the applicant's significant volunteer efforts in one or more community service projects, followed by financial need or academic achievement.

Applications for the scholarship, which is currently \$1500, can be obtained from the Armuchee Ruritan website under the Scholarships tab and must be submitted to the Armuchee High School guidance counselor by March 10.

STEP 1: Print application from the Armuchee Ruritan website and fill out all the information requested.

STEP 2: Attach a one-page narrative describing your short and long-term goals.

STEP 3: Return to guidance counselor by March 10 and have a copy of your high school transcript attached.
